

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Government of India is planning to barter surplus sugar for pulses with countries like Canada, Indonesia and Malaysia. India imports around 3-4 MMT of pulses to meet its domestic demand and exports around 18-19 MMT of sugar with carryout of 10 MMT.

According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the last week (27-July-02 Aug) was around 110 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 15% higher than previous week's (July 20-July 26), import of 96 thousand tonnes. Chana, Kidney Bean, Urad, Tur, Moong and Yellow Pea were imported lower this week whereas Green Pea, Cow Pea and Masoor were imported higher as compared to last week.

According to the trade sources, Tur area in Gulbarga region of Karnataka is likely to surge this year by around 5-10% as compared to the previous year. However yield could be impacted downwardly as no rain spills have received in last 15-20 days.

Area under Kharif pulses throughout the country stood 92.64 lakh hectares as on 07 August this year, around 14.0% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 81.24 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

Area under Kharif pulses in Andhra Pradesh stood 1.04 Lakh Hectares as on 05 August this year, around 2% higher as compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 1.02 Lakh hectares. But the area of Black gram has decreased as compared to last year.

According to the Rajasthan Department of Agriculture, the production estimate of Gram in 2014-15 is only 9.10 Lakh tonnes as compare to 16.40 Lakh tones in 2013-14 which is around 45% lower than last year. Rajasthan is the country's second producing state and this decline in production will not make the prices to decline steeply in near term.

The Wholesale price index for Pulses for the month of June, 2015 rose to 308.9 from 284 in previous month. The Pulses annual rate of inflation based on monthly WPI, stood at 8.7% for June 2015 as compared with 7.53% in the previous month.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the local traders, no major damage occurred in Canadian Pulses** by frost and even the warm weather that followed has been ideal for crop development. They are estimating 3.75 million acres of the lentil crop, which is well above Statistics Canada's 3.35 million acre estimate and 3.9 million acres of peas, comprising three million acres of yellow and 870,000 acres of green peas. That is higher in line with Statistics Canada's 3.83 million acre estimate.
- **Australian Chickpea is currently being planted and should be finished in the end of June.** Weather condition is favorable and yield may increase this year as compare to last year. Harvest is set to begin after

September. Demand and prices of Australian chickpeas increased due to crop failure in India. Australia exports around 95% of its chickpea crop where India, Bangladesh and UAE are its major export destination.

- **China for the second year in a row was net importer of Pulses.** According to the latest report compiled by STAT it imported 2.50 MMT of pulses in 2014 against 5.67 MMT in 2013. In 2014 it imported 8.17 MMT of pulses against export of 5.67 MMT. China was a net exporter of pulses until the 2013 calendar year. In 2012, China exported 3.67 MMT more pulses than it imported.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender for 1000 metric tonne (MT) of yellow split pea for May -June shipment.**
- **Field pea exports from France during the month of February** totaled 10,927 metric tons (MT) which is down by 19% from the 13,700 MT shipped in the month of January, and down 11% from the 12,470 MT shipped the same month last year. Shipments so far this season are down 36% at 83,555 MT. Most peas were shipped to European destinations, with Belgium the most important, followed by Switzerland and Italy. No field pea shipments were reported to Egypt or the Indian subcontinent.
