

### Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Area under Kharif pulses throughout the country stood 101.96 lakh hectares as on 21 August this year, around 10.0% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 92.57 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

Area under Kharif pulses in Andhra Pradesh stood 1.50 Lakh Hectares as on 19 August this year, around 24% higher as compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 1.21 Lakh hectares. The area of Green gram has shown the highest increase of 210% as compared to last year.

According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the last week (10 Aug-16 Aug) was around 71 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 13% lower than previous week's (03 Aug-09 Aug), import of 81 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Kidney Bean, Toor and Moong were imported lower this week whereas Green Pea, Cow Pea, Urad, Yellow Pea and Masoor were imported higher as compared to last week.

Department of Agriculture and Co-operation, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its fourth advance estimates, has revised down the pulses production for the season 2014-15 at 17.20 million tonnes, which was earlier estimated to be around 17.38 million tons in third advance estimates. Production target for the season 2014-15 has been set at 19.50 million tons. Pulses production according to final estimates of DAC for the season 2013-14 was 19.25 million tons.

Jalandhar district administration has put stock limit on traders of pulses to control the rising prices. Traders, including wholesalers and distributors and selling agents can have maximum stock limit of 10,000 quintals while retailers can retain 5,000 quintals of pulses.

Firmness in Tur market continues on rising fear of lower acreage on deficit rainfall allover India. IMD latest update says 10 percent deficit rainfall so far and it may increase to 12 percent by the end of rainy season till September. Market participants and growers have started expressing concern about emerging possibility of lower tur production in states of Maharashtra and Karnataka. All these developments at sowing stage have supported pulses market and uptrend is likely to be continued in the days ahead.

Government of India is planning to barter surplus sugar for pulses with countries like Canada, Indonesia and Malaysia. India imports around 3-4 MMT of pulses to meet its domestic demand and exports around 18-19 MMT of sugar with carryout of 10 MMT.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- According to the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS), pulses net import in fiscal year (July to June) 2014-15 was around 6.60 Lakh tonnes which were around 32 % higher than 2013-14 that was 4.99 Lakh tonnes. Pakistan imports around 50-60 Lakh tonnes of pulses annually to meet its demand mainly from countries like Australia, Burma, Tanzania and Ethiopia.

- **According to the Union Nationale Interprofessionnelle des Plantes Riches en Proteines (UNIP), French Pea exports in the month of June were 33720 MT which is around 245% higher than the month of May that was 9740 MT. The increase in exports is due to good demand of pea from Indian subcontinent.**
- **According to the local traders, no major damage occurred in Canadian Pulses** by frost and even the warm weather that followed has been ideal for crop development. They are estimating 3.75 million acres of the lentil crop, which is well above Statistics Canada's 3.35 million acre estimate and 3.9 million acres of peas, comprising three million acres of yellow and 870,000 acres of green peas. That is higher in line with Statistics Canada's 3.83 million acre estimate.
- **China for the second year in a row was net importer of Pulses.** According to the latest report compiled by STAT it imported 2.50 MMT of pulses in 2014 against 5.67 MMT in 2013. In 2014 it imported 8.17 MMT of pulses against export of 5.67 MMT. China was a net exporter of pulses until the 2013 calendar year. In 2012, China exported 3.67 MMT more pulses than it imported.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 1000 metric tonne (MT) of yellow split pea for May -June shipment.
