

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Area under Kharif pulses throughout the country stood 105.52 lakh hectares as on 28 August this year, around 12% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 94.18 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the last week (17 Aug-23 Aug) was around 62 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 12% lower than previous week's (10 Aug-16 Aug), import of 71 Thousand tonnes. Urad, Masoor, Cow Pea and Green Pea were imported lower this week whereas Chana, Kidney Bean, Tur, Yellow Pea and Moong were imported higher as compared to last week.

Area under Kharif pulses in Andhra Pradesh stood 1.77 Lakh Hectares as on 26 August this year, around 35% higher as compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 1.31 Lakh hectares. The area of Green gram has shown the highest increase of 228% as compared to last year.

Government had imported 5000 tonnes of Tur Dal at Rs 77/kg which is scheduled to be arrived on the ports between 1-15 September. Viewing higher prices in the domestic market government had decided to offer Rs 10 kg subsidy on imported Tur dal and will be distributed among states at Rs 67 per kg.

According to senior officials of the Maharashtra Agriculture Department, pulses have been sown on 17 lakh hectares which is around 32 % lower than last year which was 25 Lakh Hectares. Moreover, late sowing and poor rains are likely to affect productivity.

With rising pulses prices and political pressure state government has started taking action to curb pulses prices. In a latest move Odisha government has made it mandatory for shops to display the quantity of pulses available in the shop under Essential Commodities Act and conducting raids to check black marketing. Traders of the state have had a meeting with government officials and suggested some measures like removing VAT on Pulses to contain increasing prices immediately.

Department of Agriculture and Co-operation, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its fourth advance estimates, has revised down the pulses production for the season 2014-15 at 17.20 million tonnes, which was earlier estimated to be around 17.38 million tons in third advance estimates. Production target for the season 2014-15 has been set at 19.50 million tons. Pulses production according to final estimates of DAC for the season 2013-14 was 19.25 million tons.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS), pulses net import in fiscal year** (July to June) 2014-15 was around 6.60 Lakh tonnes which were around 32 % higher than 2013-14 that was 4.99 Lakh tonnes. Pakistan imports around 50-60 Lakh tonnes of pulses annually to meet its demand mainly from countries like Australia, Burma, Tanzania and Ethiopia.
- **According to the Union Nationale Interprofessionnelle des Plantes Riches en Proteines (UNIP),** French Pea exports in the month of June were 33720 MT which is around 245% higher than the month of May that was 9740 MT. The increase in exports is due to good demand of pea from Indian subcontinent.
- **According to the local traders, no major damage occurred in Canadian Pulses** by frost and even the warm weather that followed has been ideal for crop development. They are estimating 3.75 million acres of the lentil crop, which is well above Statistics Canada's 3.35 million acre estimate and 3.9 million acres of peas, comprising three million acres of yellow and 870,000 acres of green peas. That is higher in line with Statistics Canada's 3.83 million acre estimate.

- **China for the second year in a row was net importer of Pulses.** According to the latest report compiled by STAT it imported 2.50 MMT of pulses in 2014 against 5.67 MMT in 2013. In 2014 it imported 8.17 MMT of pulses against export of 5.67 MMT. China was a net exporter of pulses until the 2013 calendar year. In 2012, China exported 3.67 MMT more pulses than it imported.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender for 1000 metric tonne (MT) of yellow split pea for May -June shipment.**
