

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Area under Kharif pulses throughout the country stood 108.37 lakh hectares as on 04 September this year, around 11% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 97.56 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.
- Area under Kharif pulses in Andhra Pradesh stood 1.97 Lakh Hectares as on 02 September this year, around 44% higher than 1.37 Lakh hectares of area sown during corresponding period last year. The area of Green gram has shown the highest increase as compared to last year.
- According to the Gujarat Agriculture Department First Advance Estimate 2015-16, total pulses production has been set at 3.74 Lakh tonnes with area of 4.43 Lakh Hectares and yield of 843 kg/Ha. The estimated area is marginally increased from normal area which is 4.41 Lakh Hectares. However, pulses in Gujarat stood at 4.14 Lakh Hectares as on 31 August this year, around 10% higher than 3.78 hectares of area sown during corresponding period last year.
- Government has decided to import additional 5000 MT of tur through MMTC in coming days to curb rising prices. Already, MMTC has tendered to import of 5,000 tonnes of tur and urad dal each which will land in the country by September 5. The imported dals will be supplied to state governments at subsidized rates for further distribution to retail consumers.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the last week (24 Aug-30 Aug) was around 103 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 66% higher than previous week's (17 Aug-23 Aug), import of 62 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Kidney Bean, Masoor, Urad, Moong and Green Pea were imported lower this week whereas; Tur, Yellow Pea and Cow Pea were imported higher as compared to last week.
- With favorable weather condition and increased MSP Tur farmers started early sowing and area was expected to increase considerably (7 to 10 percent) in the beginning. But with the span of time deficit rainfall started affecting the normal hope for higher production now. As per the latest Ministry of Agriculture report, all India Tur sowing area stood at 34.30 Lakh Ha which is around 2% higher than last year which was 33.58 Lakh Ha at the same period.
- Government had imported 5000 tonnes of Tur Dal at Rs 77/kg which is scheduled to be arrived on the ports between 1-15 September. Viewing higher prices in the domestic market government had decided to offer Rs 10 kg subsidy on imported Tur dal and will be distributed among states at Rs 67 per kg.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16 is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- According to the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS), pulses net import in fiscal year (July to June) 2014-15 was around 6.60 Lakh tonnes which were around 32 % higher than 2013-14 that was 4.99 Lakh tonnes. Pakistan imports around 50-60 Lakh tonnes of pulses annually to meet its demand mainly from countries like Australia, Burma, Tanzania and Ethiopia.

- **According to the Union Nationale Interprofessionnelle des Plantes Riches en Proteines (UNIP)**, French Pea exports in the month of June were 33720 MT which is around 245% higher than the month of May that was 9740 MT. The increase in exports is due to good demand of pea from Indian subcontinent.
- **According to the local traders, no major damage occurred in Canadian Pulses** by frost and even the warm weather that followed has been ideal for crop development. They are estimating 3.75 million acres of the lentil crop, which is well above Statistics Canada's 3.35 million acre estimate and 3.9 million acres of peas, comprising three million acres of yellow and 870,000 acres of green peas. That is higher in line with Statistics Canada's 3.83 million acre estimate.
- **China for the second year in a row was net importer of Pulses.** According to the latest report compiled by STAT it imported 2.50 MMT of pulses in 2014 against 5.67 MMT in 2013. In 2014 it imported 8.17 MMT of pulses against export of 5.67 MMT. China was a net exporter of pulses until the 2013 calendar year. In 2012, China exported 3.67 MMT more pulses than it imported.
