

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- With a view of boosting production of pulses at domestic front the CACP has recommended hike in MSP of Chickpeas Rs 3425 per quintal from 3175 and lentil to Rs 3,325 from Rs 3,075 per quintal.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the last week (14 Sept-20 Sept) was around 85 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 27% higher than previous week's (07 Sept-13 Sept), import of 67 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Green Pea, Kidney Bean and Masoor were imported lower this week whereas Pigeon Pea, Moong, Cow Pea, Urad and Yellow Pea were imported higher as compared to last week.
- Central Government extends the stock limit on pulses by one year to September 2016 and states will be allowed to take necessary steps to curb rising prices. Warehouse registered with WDRA would be subjected to the same stock limits imposed by State Governments except exporters, those who store raw material for food processing and supplier to retailers have been exempted.
- According to the latest release by Ministry of Agriculture ,All India Tur , Urad and Moong sowing area is 35.75,27.68 and 25.42 Lakh Hectare which is around 4%,10% and 21% higher than last year that was 35.95,25.25and 21.02 respectively.
- Area under Kharif pulses throughout the country stood 112.42 Lakh hectares as on 18 September this year, around 12% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 100.72 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.
- Area under Kharif pulses in Andhra Pradesh stood 2.40 Lakh Hectares as on 16 September this year, around 53% higher as compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 1.57 Lakh hectares. The area of Red Gram and Green gram has shown the highest increase as compared to last year.
- According to the first advance estimate 2015-16 by Ministry of Agriculture, pulses Kharif production is estimated to be 5.56 MMT which is around 1% lower than the fourth estimate of 2014-15 that was 5.63 MMT. Tur production is estimated to decline to 2.61 MMT as compare to 2.71 MMT (4th estimate 2014-15) but Urad production is estimated to increase to 1.37 MMT from 1.27 MMT.
- According to the Gujarat Agriculture Department First Advance Estimate 2015-16, total pulses production has been set at 3.74 Lakh tonnes with area of 4.43 Lakh Hectares and yield of 843 kg/Ha. The estimated area is marginally increased from normal area which is 4.41 Lakh Hectares .However, pulses in Gujarat stood at 4.14 Lakh Hectares as on 31 August this year, around 10% higher than 3.78 hectares of area sown during corresponding period last year.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the statpub, Canada Lentil No. 1 variety harvest** could increase from 5% (last year) to 12 % this year and No.2 variety from 32% to 59% this year whereas No.3 and sample grade decreased from 53% and 10% to 27% and 2% respectively. Canadian lentil No. 2 variety is the FAQ (fair average quality) variety.
- **According to the Union Nationale Interprofessionnelle des Plantes Riches en Proteines (UNIP)**, French Pea exports in the month of July were 34130 MT which is around 1% higher than the month of June that was 33720 MT. The increase in exports is due to good demand of pea from Indian subcontinent.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2015-16 is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS), pulses net import in fiscal year** (July to June) 2014-15 was around 6.60 Lakh tonnes which were around 32 % higher than 2013-14 that was 4.99 Lakh tonnes.

Pakistan imports around 50-60 Lakh tonnes of pulses annually to meet its demand mainly from countries like Australia, Burma, Tanzania and Ethiopia.

- **According to the local traders, no major damage occurred in Canadian Pulses** by frost and even the warm weather that followed has been ideal for crop development. They are estimating 3.75 million acres of the lentil crop, which is well above Statistics Canada's 3.35 million acre estimate and 3.9 million acres of peas, comprising three million acres of yellow and 870,000 acres of green peas. That is higher in line with Statistics Canada's 3.83 million acre estimate.
