

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the last week (05 Oct-11Oct) was around 58 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 21% lower than previous week's (28 Sept-04Oct), import of 72 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Kidney Bean, Green Pea, Urad and Moong were imported higher this week whereas Masoor, Cow Pea, Pigeon Pea and Yellow Pea were imported lower as compared to last week.
- The Wholesale price index for Pulses for the month of September, 2015 rose to 333.8 from 326 in previous month. The Pulses annual rate of inflation based on monthly WPI, stood at 2.39% for September 2015 as compared to 2.58% in the previous month.
- Tur crop in Gulbarga needs one winter rains in next 10 to 15 days for better yield and flowering. Currently, standing crop has entered into flowering stage and the process would continue two to three weeks from now. One good shower of rains may increase numbers of flowers and it would enhance yield. However, farmers express fear of lower yield if rains get delayed by a fortnight. Such condition may reduce expected yield by half. Actually, winter rains in between third and fourth week of Oct remains crucial for the final size of the tur crop.
- With the rise of festive demand and decreased pace of arrival from local market and import, the prices of urad continued to lend support in the cash market and resultantly prices firmed up. According to the preliminary advance estimate released by Agriwatch, urad Kharif production is likely to be around 10.7 Lakh tonnes which is around 22 percent lower than the 1st advance estimate release by Government of India of 13.7 Lakh tonnes.
- With a view of boosting production of pulses at domestic front the CACP has recommended hike in MSP of Chickpeas Rs 3425 per quintal from 3175 and lentil to Rs 3,325 from Rs 3,075 per quintal.
- According to the latest release by Ministry of Agriculture, All India Tur, Urad and Moong sowing area is 35.75, 27.68 and 25.42 Lakh Hectare which is around 4%, 10% and 21% higher than last year that was 35.95, 25.25 and 21.02 respectively.
- Area under Kharif pulses throughout the country stood 112.42 Lakh hectares as on 18 September this year, around 12% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 100.72 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.
- According to the first advance estimate 2015-16 by Ministry of Agriculture, pulses Kharif production is estimated to be 5.56 MMT which is around 1% lower than the fourth estimate of 2014-15 that was 5.63 MMT. Tur production is estimated to decline to 2.61 MMT as compare to 2.71 MMT (4th estimate 2014-15) but Urad production is estimated to increase to 1.37 MMT from 1.27 MMT.
- According to the Gujarat Agriculture Department First Advance Estimate 2015-16, total pulses production has been set at 3.74 Lakh tonnes with area of 4.43 Lakh Hectares and yield of 843 kg/Ha. The estimated area is marginally increased from normal area which is 4.41 Lakh Hectares. However, pulses in Gujarat stood at 4.14 Lakh Hectares as on 31 August this year, around 10% higher than 3.78 hectares of area sown during corresponding period last year.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- According to the Union Nationale Interprofessionnelle des Plantes Riches en Proteines (UNIP), French Pea exports in the month of August was 37285 MT which is around 9% higher than the month of July that was 34130 MT. The increase in exports is due to good demand of pea from India which imported 23,261 MT of peas in August month.

- **According to the stat pub, Canada Lentil Production for 2015-16 is expected to increase by 5 percent to 2.083 MMT.** Canada had produced 1.987 MMT last year. Despite hope for higher production export volume is likely to decrease from 2.229 to 2.0 MMT in 2015-16. Canada growers predict the price range for all lentils in between \$750-\$780 in 2015-16 due to better prospects of export demand. Lentil prices were ruling \$585 (average) per tonne in the last season. As prices are expected to rule higher, local sellers and stockists, even farmers would prefer to retain stock for garnering maximum profit and it may slow down the current pace of export volume.
- **According to the statpub, Canada Lentil No. 1 variety harvest** could increase from 5% (last year) to 12 % this year and No.2 variety from 32% to 59% this year whereas No.3 and sample grade decreased from 53% and 10% to 27% and 2% respectively. Canadian lentil No. 2 variety is the FAQ (fair average quality) variety.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16 is 990 kilo tonnes** which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS), pulses net import in fiscal year** (July to June) 2014-15 was around 6.60 Lakh tonnes which were around 32 % higher than 2013-14 that was 4.99 Lakh tonnes. Pakistan imports around 50-60 Lakh tonnes of pulses annually to meet its demand mainly from countries like Australia, Burma, Tanzania and Ethiopia.
