

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Considering the drastic rise in the pulses prices in domestic market and huge gap between supply and demand, commerce ministry will hold a meeting with importers on Thursday i.e. 03 Dec. Along with the secretaries from Consumer Affairs and Agriculture, the Secretary of Commerce will discuss the strategies of importer particularly in order deal with the current situations of pulses prices.
- State governments have released around 21 Thousand tonnes of seized pulses in the market till now to stabilize rising prices. Government has seized around 1.33 Lakh tonnes till 30th November. Prices has shown some downward movement due to measures taken by Government such as imposition of stock limit, raid on hoarders and selling of pulses at subsidized rate.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Gram area till date (as on 27.11.2015) was registered at 65.14 Lakh Ha which was around 1% higher than the last year in the corresponding period. .Last year it was 64.58 Lakh ha. Till date sowing area of Gram in Maharashtra it has increased whereas in Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh it has decreased as compare to last year.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Masoor area till date (as on 27.11.2015) was registered at 8.42 Lakh Ha which was around 28% lower than the last year in the corresponding period. .Last year it was 11.70 Lakh ha. Till date area of sowing in Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra and Bihar has decreased as compare to last year due to lower rainfall.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Rabi Urad area till date (as on 27.11.2015) was registered at 2.37 Lakh Ha which was around 1% lower than the last year in the corresponding period. .Last year it was 2.40 Lakh ha. Despite lower area coverage at present, Agriwatch expects higher sowing area at the end of the season due to higher prevailing market prices.
- According to the Ministry of Agriculture, area under Rabi pulses throughout the country stood 90.91 lakh hectares as on 27th November this year, around 7% lower when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 97.80 Lakh hectares.
- Telangana State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited issues tender to purchase 12,000 MT Tur Dal for December /January shipment .Last date for bidding is 30th November, 2015.
- According to the latest Andhra Pradesh Agriculture Ministry report, pulses area is 4.49 Lakh Ha as on 25th November,2015 which is around 41% higher than the last year at the same time area of 3.18 Lakh Ha. The highest percentage increase in area as compare to last year was recorded in Urad due to higher prevailing market prices.
- According to the trade source, Tur crop yield in Sedam district of Karnataka may decrease around 20-30% from last year due to less rainfall. The price for the new crop was quoted at Rs11400 to Rs 11500 per quintal. It has moisture level of around 15-16% with arrival of 400-500 bags per day.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (16 Nov-22 Nov) was around 146 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 132% higher than previous week's (09 Nov-15 Nov) import of 63 Thousand tonnes. All pulses except cow pea were imported higher this week.
- According the local farmers and trade source from Kanpur region of Uttar Pradesh, rabi pulses sown area may decrease due less rainfall which affects the soil moisture and thus farmers could shifts towards other crops or delay the sowing of pulses.
- New harvested Tur crop starts hitting Solapur market of Maharashtra region. New tur prices are in the range of 11400to 11700, having moisture level of 15-16%, higher than normal. Arrivals are being reported around 100-150 bags per day. As the weather condition is cloudy, arrival pace may get delayed.
- According to the Gujarat Revised Kharif Pulses Advance Estimate, Pulses Kharif production is estimated to be 347 thousand tonnes which is around 7% lower than the previous estimate of 374 thousand tonnes. Lower estimate is due to expectation of lower yield.
- According to the latest inflation update released by Government of India, Pulses Monthly Wholesale Price Index for the month of October is 364.4 which are around 9 % higher than the month of September. In month of September Wholesale Price Index was 333.8.
- From the total volume of 1.33 lakh tons of pulses seized from the hoarders in across the India, around 4,660 tons has been released in the open market in order ot relief the consumers from the skyrocketed pulses prices.

- **Demand for Canadian lentil has been on the rise in recent weeks** and its reflections are being seen on bidding prices. Cash bid for Canadian lentil has been moving northward and has reached at Canadian \$ 1233 per tonne in the last week of November. The main reasons for rising prices are mainly attributed to, improved demand, weak local currency and hope for uptrend to continue.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 22,020 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for January -February shipment as food aid.
- **According to the trade sources, Burmese Tur crop** is in good condition and they are estimating around 3-3.5 Lakh MT productions this year. Buyers are asking \$1275(CNF) for January-February contract.
- **According to the local trader in Yangon, Urad stocks** at present may be around 3-4 thousand tones. At present contracts are at \$1825-1835 (FOB) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ).
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Lentil Production for 2015-16** is expected to increase by around 9 percent to 2.162 MMT. Canada had produced 1.987 MMT last year. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.2 MMT in 2015-16 from 2.18 MMT last year. Grower's bids are forecasted to be in the price range of \$780-\$810 for all lentils in 2015-16 due to better prospects of export demand. Lentil prices were ruling \$585 (average) per tonne in the last season.
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Peas Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease** by around 17 percent to 3.15 MMT. Canada had produced 3.81 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.9 MMT this year from 3.09 last year and ending stock are forecasted to reach from 4.29 MMT last year to 1 MMT this year. Lower production and resultantly lower carryout would push local farmers bid maximum to \$325 per tonne.
- **Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease by around 20 percent** to 1.05 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 85,000 MT this year from 80,000 last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.09 MMT .Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$600-625 per tonne.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2015-16 is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
