

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the Ministry of Agriculture, area under Rabi pulses throughout the country stood 114.51 lakh hectares as on 11th December this year, around 1% lower when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 115.34 Lakh hectares.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Chana area till date (as on 11.12.2015) was registered at 75.12 Lakh Ha which was around 3% higher than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 72.98 Lakh ha. Till date sowing area of Chana in Maharashtra has increased whereas in Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh it has decreased as compare to last year but now its gaining some momentum.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Peas area till date (as on 11.12.2015) was registered at 9.17 Lakh Ha which was around 3% lower than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 9.43 Lakh ha. Peas Sowing Area in Madhya Pradesh till date has increased by 69% this year as compare to last year from 2.63 Lakh Ha to 4.45 Lakh Ha.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Rabi Urad area till date (as on 11.12.2015) was registered at 4.51 Lakh Ha which was around 23% higher than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 3.66 Lakh ha.
- In order to curb down the rising prices and enhance domestic supply of pulses, Government has released over 68000 tonnes of seized pulses till now. Government has seized around 1.30 Lakh tonnes of pulses during raids on hoarders.
- Government approves to create 1.5 Lakh Tonnes of pulses buffer stock. Pulses will be procured at market price through FCI, SFAC and other agencies. According to an official statement, 50000 tonnes pulses from Kharif crop and 1Lakh tonnes pulses from Rabi crop will be procured.
- According to trade sources, FCI and Nafed had started buying urad at market rate from Rajasthan and Maharashtra for pulses buffer stock. Urad prices are ruling in the range of Rs 10,000 to 11000 per quintal. However, pace of buying remains slow and is expected to pick momentum in coming weeks.
- According to the latest Andhra Pradesh Agriculture Ministry report, pulses area is 6.28 Lakh Ha as on 09th December,2015 which is around 44% higher than the last year at the same time area of 4.36 Lakh Ha. The highest percentage increase in area as compare to last year was recorded in Urad due to higher prevailing market prices.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (23 Nov-29 Nov) was around 171 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 6% higher than previous week's (23 Nov-29 Nov) import of 160 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Kidney Bean, Cow Pea, Green Pea, Moong and Yellow Pea were imported lower this week whereas Masoor, Pigeon Pea and Urad were imported lower as compared to last week.
- Government of India is planning to import more pulses primarily lentils in order to fulfill the supply lag which is causing the domestic price to surge up drastically. In a meeting with importers recently, Commerce Ministry asked to assess the domestic demand and the quantity required to be imported for the domestic use. The country has imported around 2.23 million tons of pulses in the first half of year 2015-16.
- State governments have released around 21 Thousand tonnes of seized pulses in the market till now to stabilize rising prices. Government has seized around 1.33 Lakh tonnes till 30th November. Prices has shown some downward movement due to measures taken by Government such as imposition of stock limit, raid on hoarders and selling of pulses at subsidized rate.
- Telangana State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited issues tender to purchase 12,000 MT Tur Dal for December /January shipment. Last date for bidding is 30th November, 2015.
- According to the trade source, Tur crop yield in Sedam district of Karnataka may decrease around 20-30% from last year due to less rainfall. The price for the new crop was quoted at Rs11400 to Rs 11500 per quintal. It has moisture level of around 15-16% with arrival of 400-500 bags per day.
- New harvested Tur crop starts hitting Solapur market of Maharashtra region. New tur prices are in the range of 11400to 11700, having moisture level of 15-16%, higher than normal. Arrivals are being reported around 100-150 bags per day. As the weather condition is cloudy, arrival pace may get delayed.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **Demand for Canadian lentil has been on the rise in recent weeks** and its reflections are being seen on bidding prices. Cash bid for Canadian lentil has been moving northward and has reached at Canadian \$ 1233 per tonne in the last week of November. The main reasons for rising prices are mainly attributed to, improved demand, weak local currency and hope for uptrend to continue.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 22,020 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for January -February shipment as food aid.
- **According to the trade sources, Burmese Tur crop** is in good condition and they are estimating around 3-3.5 Lakh MT productions this year. Buyers are asking \$1275(CNF) for January-February contract.
- **According to the local trader in Yangon, Urad stocks** at present may be around 3-4 thousand tones. At present contracts are at \$1825-1835 (FOB) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ).
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Lentil Production for 2015-16** is expected to increase by around 9 percent to 2.162 MMT. Canada had produced 1.987 MMT last year. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.2 MMT in 2015-16 from 2.18 MMT last year. Grower's bids are forecasted to be in the price range of \$780-\$810 for all lentils in 2015-16 due to better prospects of export demand. Lentil prices were ruling \$585 (average) per tonne in the last season.
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Peas Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease** by around 17 percent to 3.15 MMT. Canada had produced 3.81 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.9 MMT this year from 3.09 last year and ending stock are forecasted to reach from 4.29 MMT last year to 1 MMT this year. Lower production and resultantly lower carryout would push local farmers bid maximum to \$325 per tonne.
- **Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease by around 20 percent** to 1.05 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 85,000 MT this year from 80,000 last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.09 MMT .Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$600-625 per tonne.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
