

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the Ministry of Agriculture, area under Rabi pulses throughout the country stood 123.70 lakh hectares as on 18th December this year, around 1.2% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 122.26 Lakh hectares.
- According to the latest Andhra Pradesh Agriculture Ministry report, pulses area is 7.19 Lakh Ha as on 12th December, 2015 which is around 32% higher than the last year at the same time area of 5.45 Lakh Ha. Urad sowing area has increased from 1.66 Lakh Ha to 2.52 Lakh Ha this year.
- Arrivals from newly harvested Tur crop in Solapur market of Maharashtra are being reported around 2500-3000 bags per day. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 10100 to 10500 per quintal, having moisture level of 14-16%. According to the local traders, tur yield has dropped down around 25-30 percent this year as compared to last year due to lower rainfall.
- Center and state governments are trying to contain pulses prices by adopting all possible measures and till last month 54000 tonne pulses were seized by Chhattisgarh government. As stock is not sufficient for the whole year, any unexpected slide from current level is unlikely. However, new arrival pressure may drag current prices down to some extent.
- Government has been releasing seized pulses to increase availability in domestic market and to curb down the rising prices. Till now government has released around 93.5 thousand tonnes from 130 thousand tonnes of seized pulses. Pulses prices have shown downward trend due to lower demand and higher availability in physical market. Imposition of stock limit and increased availability in domestic market continues to weigh on market fundamentals.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (07 Dec-13 Dec) was around 158 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 8% lower than previous week's (30 Nov-06 Dec) import of 171 Thousand tonnes. Pigeon Pea, Kidney Bean, Green Pea, Moong and Yellow Pea were imported lower this week whereas Cow Pea, Chana, Masoor, and Urad were imported higher as compared to last week.
- Arrival starts from newly harvested Urad crop in limited quantity in Guntur mandi. The price for the new crop was quoted at Rs 9500 to Rs 10500 per quintal. As new crop has higher moisture level of 15-16%, traders are offering lower quotes for the produce.
- According to the latest inflation update released by Government of India, Pulses Monthly Wholesale Price Index for the month of November, 2015 rose to 380.4 from 364.4 in previous month. The Pulses annual rate of inflation based on monthly WPI, stood at 4.39% for November 2015 as compared to 9.16% in the previous month.
- According to the local trader and farmers of Patna region in Bihar, masoor sowing area may increase by 15-20% this year as compared to last year. Sowing in these regions is likely to be completed by around December end. Early sown masoor may have better yield prospects.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Chana area till date (as on 11.12.2015) was registered at 75.12 Lakh Ha which was around 3% higher than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 72.98 Lakh ha. Till date sowing area of Chana in Maharashtra has increased whereas in Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh it has decreased as compared to last year but now it's gaining some momentum.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Peas area till date (as on 11.12.2015) was registered at 9.17 Lakh Ha which was around 3% lower than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 9.43 Lakh ha. Peas Sowing Area in Madhya Pradesh till date has increased by 69% this year as compared to last year from 2.63 Lakh Ha to 4.45 Lakh Ha.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Rabi Urad area till date (as on 11.12.2015) was registered at 4.51 Lakh Ha which was around 23% higher than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 3.66 Lakh ha.
- Government approves to create 1.5 Lakh Tonnes of pulses buffer stock. Pulses will be procured at market price through FCI, SFAC and other agencies. According to an official statement, 50000 tonnes pulses from Kharif crop and 1 Lakh tonnes pulses from Rabi crop will be procured.

- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 14,360 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for January-February shipment as food aid. Pulses have to be in packed in 50 kg bags.
- **Demand for Canadian lentil has been on the rise in recent weeks** and its reflections are being seen on bidding prices. Cash bid for Canadian lentil has been moving northward and has reached at Canadian \$ 1233 per tonne in the last week of November. The main reasons for rising prices are mainly attributed to, improved demand, weak local currency and hope for uptrend to continue.
- **According to the trade sources, Burmese Tur crop** is in good condition and they are estimating around 3-3.5 Lakh MT productions this year. Buyers are asking \$1275(CNF) for January-February contract.
- **According to the local trader in Yangon, Urad stocks** at present may be around 3-4 thousand tones. At present contracts are at \$1825-1835 (FOB) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ).
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Lentil Production for 2015-16** is expected to increase by around 9 percent to 2.162 MMT. Canada had produced 1.987 MMT last year. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.2 MMT in 2015-16 from 2.18 MMT last year. Grower's bids are forecasted to be in the price range of \$780-\$810 for all lentils in 2015-16 due to better prospects of export demand. Lentil prices were ruling \$585 (average) per tonne in the last season.
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Peas Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease** by around 17 percent to 3.15 MMT. Canada had produced 3.81 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.9 MMT this year from 3.09 last year and ending stock are forecasted to reach from 4.29 MMT last year to 1 MMT this year. Lower production and resultantly lower carryout would push local farmers bid maximum to \$325 per tonne.
- **Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease by around 20 percent** to 1.05 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 85,000 MT this year from 80,000 last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.09 MMT .Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$600-625 per tonne.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2015-16 is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
