

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the local trade, FCI is procuring Tur from Gulbarga Region of Karnataka. Tur price is ruling in the range of Rs 8500-9500 per quintal with arrival of 3000-3500 bags per day. The procurement is intended to make buffer stock to control prices in lean season by distributing it through proper channel.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (07 Dec-13 Dec) was around 265 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 68% higher than previous week's (07 Dec-13 Dec) import of 158 Thousand tonnes. Pigeon Pea, Green Pea, Cow Pea, Kidney Bean and Masoor were imported lower this week whereas Yellow Pea, Moong Chana, and Urad were imported higher as compared to last week.
- With prevailing higher prices and lower availability of stock of lentil in domestic market import has been on the rise in recent months. India has imported 1.34 lakh tonne lentil during last two weeks of December up to 13th, December-2015. Against this India had imported only 0.77 Lakh tonnes lentil in whole of December-2014. Traders are also covering their short position at this point of time because prices of lentil in Canada is expected to go up from current level and import may be costly in the months ahead.
- New harvested Chana crop starts hitting Solapur market of Maharashtra region. Prices of new chana having moisture level of 16-17% are in the range of 4800 to 4900, higher than normal. Arrivals are being reported around 40-50 bags per day.
- According to the Ministry of Agriculture, area under Rabi pulses throughout the country stood 123.70 lakh hectares as on 18th December this year, around 1.2% higher when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 122.26 Lakh hectares.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Chana area till date (as on 18.12.2015) was registered at 79.17 Lakh Ha which was around 4% higher than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 75.82 Lakh ha. Till date sowing area of Chana in Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka has increased whereas in Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh it has decreased as compare to last year.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Peas area till date (as on 18.12.2015) was registered at 9.42 Lakh Ha which was around 3% lower than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 9.73 Lakh ha. Peas Sowing Area in Madhya Pradesh till date has increased by 60% this year as compare to last year from 2.78 Lakh Ha to 4.45 Lakh Ha.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Rabi Urad area till date (as on 18.12.2015) was registered at 5.61 Lakh Ha which was around 9% higher than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 5.16 Lakh ha. Urad area in Andhra Pradesh has increased from 1.66 to 2.52 Lakh ha this year as on date due to higher domestic prices.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Lentil area till date (as on 18.12.2015) was registered at 12.61 Lakh Ha which was around 13% lower than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 14.46 Lakh ha.
- According to the latest Andhra Pradesh Agriculture Ministry report, pulses area is 7.19 Lakh Ha as on 12th December, 2015 which is around 32% higher than the last year at the same time area of 5.45 Lakh Ha. Urad sowing area has increased from 1.66 Lakh Ha to 2.52 Lakh Ha this year.
- Arrivals from newly harvested Tur crop in Solapur market of Maharashtra are being reported around 2500-3000 bags per day. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 10100 to 10500 per quintal, having moisture level of 14-16%. According to the local traders, tur yield has dropped down around 25-30 percent this year as compare to last year due to lower rainfall.
- Government has been releasing seized pulses to increase availability in domestic market and to curb down the rising prices. Till now government has released around 93.5 thousand tonnes from 130 thousand tonnes of seized pulses. Pulses prices have shown downward trend due to lower demand and higher availability in physical market. Imposition of stock limit and increased availability in domestic market continues to weigh on market fundamentals.

- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 14,360 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for January-February shipment as food aid. Pulses have to be in packed in 50 kg bags.
- **Demand for Canadian lentil has been on the rise in recent weeks** and its reflections are being seen on bidding prices. Cash bid for Canadian lentil has been moving northward and has reached at Canadian \$ 1233 per tonne in the last week of November. The main reasons for rising prices are mainly attributed to, improved demand, weak local currency and hope for uptrend to continue.
- **According to the trade sources, Burmese Tur crop** is in good condition and they are estimating around 3-3.5 Lakh MT productions this year. Buyers are asking \$1275(CNF) for January-February contract.
- **According to the local trader in Yangon, Urad stocks** at present may be around 3-4 thousand tones. At present contracts are at \$1825-1835 (FOB) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ).
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Lentil Production for 2015-16** is expected to increase by around 9 percent to 2.162 MMT. Canada had produced 1.987 MMT last year. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.2 MMT in 2015-16 from 2.18 MMT last year. Grower's bids are forecasted to be in the price range of \$780-\$810 for all lentils in 2015-16 due to better prospects of export demand. Lentil prices were ruling \$585 (average) per tonne in the last season.
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Peas Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease** by around 17 percent to 3.15 MMT. Canada had produced 3.81 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.9 MMT this year from 3.09 last year and ending stock are forecasted to reach from 4.29 MMT last year to 1 MMT this year. Lower production and resultantly lower carryout would push local farmers bid maximum to \$325 per tonne.
- **Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease by around 20 percent** to 1.05 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 85,000 MT this year from 80,000 last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.09 MMT .Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$600-625 per tonne.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2015-16 is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
