

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the Ministry of Agriculture, area under Rabi pulses throughout the country stood 291.97 Lakh hectares as on 22nd January this year, around 4.5% lower when compared to the area sown during corresponding period last year which was 305.6 Lakh hectares.
- As pulses supply is in deficit side, the government is importing the same from the other nation and around 15,000 tons of pulses has been procured so far during the current season, said Food Minister Ram Vilas Paswan.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Chana area till date (as on 15.01.2016) was registered at 85.06 Lakh Ha which is almost same as the last year sowing area during the corresponding period which was 85.10 Lakh Ha.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Peas area till date (as on 15.01.2016) was registered at 9.75 Lakh Ha which was around 5.1% lower than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 10.27 Lakh ha.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Rabi Urad area till date (as on 15.01.2016) was registered at 7.47 Lakh Ha which is around 0.5% higher than last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 7.43 Lakh ha.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, Lentil area till date (as on 15.01.2016) was registered at 13.40 Lakh Ha which was around 10.6% lower than the last year in the corresponding period. Last year it was 14.99 Lakh ha.
- New Urad is coming in Vijayawada Region of Andhra Pradesh and arrival has been reported 10,000 bags per day. Current arrival is from minor crop and it will continue to hit market throughout January. Price range of new urad crop is between Rs 10000 to Rs 10400 per quintal.
- According to the local trader of Amravati from Maharashtra region, tur yield this year has decreased to 2-3 quintal/bigha from 4-5 quintal/bigha last year. At present Tur price is being traded at Rs 8700-9200 per quintal depending on quality of the grains and arrival has been reported 10,000 bags per day.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (04 Jan-10 Jan) was around 171 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 2% higher than previous week's (28 Dec-03 Jan) import of 167 Thousand tonnes. Green Pea, Kidney Bean and Masoor were imported lower this week whereas Cow Pea, Pigeon Pea, Yellow Pea, Chana, Urad, Moong and were imported higher as compared to last week.
- Green Chana started hitting the market in Ahmed Nagar and Nagpur region. Early arrival of green Chana in this region is due to early sown crop in soybean field. Chana requires less water and farmers in these region preferred chana. It would fulfill local demand for green chana and pressure from main crop would ease. In harvesting season it would increase availability of chana and may help stabilizing price in the season.
- Masoor in Kanpur region of Uttar Pradesh is in flowering stage. The size of the grain may be lower this year due to higher than normal temperature. Rains at this stage are very crucial and it may decide the final size of the crop. According to the local traders, Masoor sowing area is lower by around 20% this year as compare to last year.
- For keeping price of pulses under check M.P. State Government has removed mandi tax on pulses imported from other states for milling purpose. It will help cost cutting of pulses milling industry. It will increase supply in local market at lower rate and millers would be able to pass on this benefit to consumers.
- To increase the supply of pulses in the domestic market and to curb down the prices of pulses, Government of India issues tender to import 5000 MT of Tur. Last date for bidding is 18th January, 2016. According to the tender, 2500 MT imported Tur has to be delivered at Mumbai port and rest at Chennai port between 7th February to 15th March, 2016.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 14,360 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for January -February shipment as food aid. Pulses have to be in packed in 50 kg bags.
- **Demand for Canadian lentil has been on the rise in recent weeks** and its reflections are being seen on bidding prices. Cash bid for Canadian lentil has been moving northward and has reached at Canadian \$ 1233 per tonne in the last week of November. The main reasons for rising prices are mainly attributed to, improved demand, weak local currency and hope for uptrend to continue.
- **According to the trade sources, Burmese Tur crop** is in good condition and they are estimating around 3-3.5 Lakh MT productions this year. Buyers are asking \$1275(CNF) for January-February contract.
- **According to the local trader in Yangon, Urad stocks** at present may be around 3-4 thousand tones. At present contracts are at \$1825-1835 (FOB) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ).
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Lentil Production for 2015-16** is expected to increase by around 9 percent to 2.162 MMT. Canada had produced 1.987 MMT last year. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.2 MMT in 2015-16 from 2.18 MMT last year. Grower's bids are forecasted to be in the price range of \$780-\$810 for all lentils in 2015-16 due to better prospects of export demand. Lentil prices were ruling \$585 (average) per tonne in the last season.
- **According to the latest Winnipeg report, Canada Peas Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease** by around 17 percent to 3.15 MMT. Canada had produced 3.81 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.9 MMT this year from 3.09 last year and ending stock are forecasted to reach from 4.29 MMT last year to 1 MMT this year. Lower production and resultantly lower carryout would push local farmers bid maximum to \$325 per tonne.
- **Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 is expected to decrease by around 20 percent** to 1.05 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 85,000 MT this year from 80,000 last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.09 MMT .Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$600-625 per tonne.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
