

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- At present arrival of tur in Amaravati mandi is 5000-5500 bags with price range of Rs 8600-8700 per bag. Arrival of Tur in Vidharba region of Madhya Pradesh is good and it may continue till February. As per market participants farmers are holding tur in expectation of better prices in future. We can expect some firmness from March onwards when arrival pressure eases.
- According to the local trader of Merta city region of Rajasthan, there is normal demand of Moong that will keep pressure on the prices in near future. At present Tur price is being traded at Rs 7800-7850 per quintal and arrival has been reported 1500-1600 bags per day. Prices may show some increase in March due to festive season.
- As per traders of Ashok Nagar region of Madhya Pradesh, new chana from non irrigated land started hitting the mandis in small quantity. Grain quality and size is normal to good. Now arrivals of chana will continue in small quantity till 1st week of March when harvesting of irrigated land will start and arrival will take pace. Overall crop condition is good.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (01 Feb-07 Feb) was around 119 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 12% lower than previous week's (25 Jan-31 Jan) import of 135 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Masoor, Pigeon Pea and Yellow Pea were imported lower this week whereas Green Pea, Urad, Cow Pea, Kidney Bean and Moong were imported higher as compared to last week.
- Chana markets' including futures recovered smartly in last few days despite new crop is round the corner. There is a gossip in market that stockiest are trying to drag market up so that they could sell their old stock at higher level and get fund for procurement from new crop. Actually, market, especially futures market has been on rise against all expectation. Generally before season stockiest intend to sell their stock at higher level and they have intentionally brought in futures to drag futures market up. When their old stocks are released, they would start selling in futures.
- Standing pea crop in Kanpur region of Uttar Pradesh is in dire need of rains as size of the grain is feared to be affected in absence of rains. Moisture stress would not allow pea under developing stage to develop fully. Lower rainfall has already affected area coverage under peas and if rains do not occur in this region this week, yield is feared to be lower than normal and reluctantly lower size of the crop. Early sowed crop is in grain filling stage while late sowed crop is in flowering stage. Both these stages need light showers of rains at regular intervals. If rains occur, production prospects would improve.
- According to the Ministry of Agriculture, final area under Rabi pulses throughout the country stood at 139.08 Lakh hectares as on 28th January this year, around 3% lower compared to the area of 143.01 Lakh hectares sown during corresponding period last year.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, final Rabi Chana area as on 28.01.2016 was registered at 85.48 Lakh Ha which is almost same as the sowing area of 85.74 Lakh Ha during the corresponding period of last year.
- According to latest report released by Ministry of Agriculture, final Peas area as on 28.01.2016 was registered at 9.79 Lakh Ha which is around 5.6% lower than the in the corresponding period last year. Last year it was 10.37 Lakh ha.
- The Wholesale price index for Pulses for the month of December, 2015 falls to 378.2 from 380.4 in previous month. The Pulses annual rate of inflation based on monthly WPI, stood at -0.58% for December 2015 as compared to 4.39% in the previous month.
- Masoor crop in Patna region of Bihar is in very good condition and farmers are expecting greater yield than last year. According to the local traders, Masoor sowing area is higher by around 20% this year as compare to last year. New crop is expected to hit the market in mid March.

- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 14,530 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for March -April shipment as food aid. Pulses have to be in packed in 50 kg bags.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production for 2015-16 increases by around 19%** to 2.4 MMT. Last year it was 1.98 MMT. Due to higher production and good demand, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT from 2.1 MMT. Season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.36 MMT to 0.10 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to increase from \$585 to \$880/910 per tonnes due to higher demand, less availability of good quality crop and weak Canadian dollar.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 31 percent** to 0.90 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 0.85 MMT this year from 0.80 MMT last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.075 MMT .Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$685-715 per tonne.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 16 percent** to 3.2 MMT. Canada had produced 3.8 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.95 MMT this year from 3.04 MMT last year. Farmer's bids are likely to increase from \$260 to \$305-335 per tonne due to good demand.
- **According to the trade sources, Burmese Tur crop** is in good condition and they are estimating around 3-3.5 Lakh MT productions this year. Buyers are asking \$1275(CNF) for January-February contract.
- **According to the local trader in Yangon, Urad stocks** at present may be around 3-4 thousand tones. At present contracts are at \$1825-1835 (FOB) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ).
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2015-16 is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
