

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to local trader of Vidisha region of Madhya Pradesh, new masoor started hitting the market in small quantity. Moisture level of new masoor is said to be in the range of 15-16 % and quality is good. Arrivals are in the range of 45-50 bags per day with price range of Rs 4400-4450 per bag. Arrival pressure in the mandi will be felt after 5-7 days and if rains occur it might delay arrival by 15-20 days. There is a fear in the market that if rains occur at this point of time, it may affect quality of new crop to some extent. Farmers are expecting higher production this year as compare to last year.
- Department of Agriculture has revised down Tur production estimate to 2.55 MMT from targeted estimate of 3.67 MMT. Despite higher coverage area, tur production has been lowered down due to lower yield expectation. Agriwatch Tur production estimate is around 2.49 MMT.
- According to the Second Advance Estimate by Government, Gram production estimate has been revised down to 8.09 MMT from targeted estimate of 9.50 MMT. Gram production estimate has been lowered due to lower area coverage against higher coverage expectation .AW estimate is around 7.89 MMT, even lower by 0.20 thousand tonne from government current estimate.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (08 Feb-14 Feb) was around 107 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 10% lower than previous week's (01 Feb-07 Feb) import of 119 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Cow Pea, Masoor, Urad and Moong were imported lower this week whereas Green Pea, Kidney Bean, Pigeon Pea and Yellow Pea were imported higher as compared to last week.
- According to local trader of Vijayawada region of Andhra Pradesh, new harvested moong crop starts hitting the market. Moisture level of the new moong cop is around 12-13% and quality is good .Arrivals are in the range of 800-1000 bags per day with the price range of Rs 6600-6700 per bag. This year Moong area in the region was lower as compared to last year as farmers have shifted to Urad crop due to higher market prices.
- According to the local trader of Bina region of Madhya Pradesh, newly harvested Masoor crop arrived in the market in small quantity. Moisture level of the crop is higher than normal which is in the range of 18-20 %.Regular flow of crop is expected after 10-15 days in the region. Overall crop condition is good.
- Current firmness in cash chana market is said to be influenced by rain prediction in March in Madhya Pradesh and Northern belt of Uttar Pradesh. Rains at that point of time will impact quality of chana and can also damage the crop. Besides, it may also delay harvesting for couple of weeks.
- According to the latest inflation update released by Government of India, Pulses Monthly Wholesale Price Index for the month of January is 370.1 which are around 2.1 % lower than the month of December. In month of December Wholesale Price Index was 378.2.
- At present arrival of tur in Amaravati mandi is 5000-5500 bags with price range of Rs 8600-8700 per bag. Arrival of Tur in Vidharba region of Madhya Pradesh is good and it may continue till February. As per market participants farmers are holding tur in expectation of better prices in future. We can expect some firmness from March onwards when arrival pressure eases.
- According to the local trader of Merta city region of Rajasthan, there is normal demand of Moong that will keep pressure on the prices in near future. At present Moong price is being traded at Rs 7800-7850 per quintal and arrival has been reported 1500-1600 bags per day. Prices may show some increase in March due to festive season.
- As per traders of Ashok Nagar region of Madhya Pradesh, new chana from non irrigated land started hitting the mandis in small quantity. Grain quality and size is normal to good. Now arrivals of chana will continue in small quantity till 1st week of March when harvesting of irrigated land will start and arrival will take pace. Overall crop condition is good.

- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 540 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for April-May shipment as food aid. Pulses have to be in packed in 50 kg bags.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation confirmed purchase of** 24,590 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for April-May shipment as food aid. Pulses have to be in packed in 50 kg bags.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production for 2015-16 increases by around 19%** to 2.4 MMT. Last year it was 1.98 MMT. Due to higher production and good demand, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT from 2.1 MMT. Season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.36 MMT to 0.10 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to increase from \$585 to \$880/910 per tonnes due to higher demand, less availability of good quality crop and weak Canadian dollar.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 31 percent** to 0.90 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 0.85 MMT this year from 0.80 MMT last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.075 MMT .Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$685-715 per tonne.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 16 percent** to 3.2 MMT. Canada had produced 3.8 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.95 MMT this year from 3.04 MMT last year. Farmer's bids are likely to increase from \$260 to \$305-335 per tonne due to good demand.
- **According to the trade sources, Burmese Tur crop** is in good condition and they are estimating around 3-3.5 Lakh MT productions this year. Buyers are asking \$1275(CNF) for January-February contract.
- **According to the local trader in Yangon, Urad stocks** at present may be around 3-4 thousand tones. At present contracts are at \$1825-1835 (FOB) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ).
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2015-16 is 990 kilo tonnes which are around 78% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
