

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the local trader of Bina region of Madhya Pradesh, new masoor started hitting the market in small quantity. Quality and size of grain is good. At present arrivals are in the range of 100-150 bags per day with price range of Rs 4500-4700 per bag.
- Harvesting of Masoor crop in Patna region of Bihar have started and crop is expected to hit the market in mid March. Crop is in very good condition and farmers are expecting 30 % greater yield than last year. Masoor sowing area is higher by around 20% this year compared to last year.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (22 Feb-28 Feb) was around 68 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 16% higher than previous week's (15 Feb-21 Feb) import of 59 Thousand tonnes. Cow Pea and Moong were imported lower this week whereas Masoor, Kidney Bean, Pigeon Pea, Chana, Green Pea, Urad and Yellow Pea were imported higher as compared to last week.
- Recent showers of rain in chana growing belt of MP may slow down harvesting activities by 3-4 days. The fear of hailstorms and rough weather this week as forecasted by IMD may hamper mature standing crop if rains occur with hailstorm. There is no report of any damage from recent rains. If rain continues harvesting of chana crop may get delay by couple of week and it may support cash market once again.
- Despite decreasing Arrival in tur market of Gulbarga prices stay steady as demand is lower at this point of time. Market participants expect prices to come down slightly from current level as quotes in International market has decreased. Millers are engaged in fulfilling their short term requirement. In brief Tur market is expected to stay steady to slightly lower in short term. However, if export quotes get firmer market might move up from current level.
- According to local trader of Jhansi region in Uttar Pradesh, pea sowing area is 20-30 % lower than last year due to lower rainfall. Arrivals of new pea crop are expected in mid March. Overall crop condition is good. At present arrivals in Jhansi mandi is in the range of 200-300 bags per day with price range of Rs 2500-2600 per bag.
- According to local trader of Dewas region of Madhya Pradesh, new chana crop quality is good. Kantewala chana production this year may be lower as compare to last year due to lower area coverage. Arrivals are in the range of 200-300 bags per day with price range of Rs 4000-4200 per bag.
- According to the local trader of Ganj Basoda region of Madhya Pradesh, new chana started hitting the market in small quantity. Grain quality and size is normal to good. Now arrivals of chana will continue in small quantity till 1st week of March when harvesting of irrigated land will start and arrival will take pace. Overall crop condition is good.
- Department of Agriculture has revised down Tur production estimate to 2.55 MMT from targeted estimate of 3.67 MMT. Despite higher coverage area, tur production has been lowered down due to lower yield expectation. Agriwatch Tur production estimate is around 2.49 MMT.
- According to the Second Advance Estimate by Government, Gram production estimate has been revised down to 8.09 MMT from targeted estimate of 9.50 MMT. Gram production estimate has been lowered due to lower area coverage against higher coverage expectation. AW estimate is around 7.89 MMT, even lower by 0.20 thousand tonne from government current estimate.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation released purchase tender** for 540 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for April-May shipment as food aid. Pulses have to be in packed in 50 kg bags.
- **USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation confirmed purchase of** 24,590 metric tonne (MT) of pulses for April-May shipment as food aid. Pulses have to be in packed in 50 kg bags.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production for 2015-16 increases by around 19%** to 2.4 MMT. Last year it was 1.98 MMT. Due to higher production and good demand, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT from 2.1 MMT. Season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.36 MMT to 0.10 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to increase from \$585 to \$880/910 per tonnes due to higher demand, less availability of good quality crop and weak Canadian dollar.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 31 percent** to 0.90 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 0.85 MMT this year from 0.80 MMT last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.075 MMT. Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$685-715 per tonne.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 16 percent** to 3.2 MMT. Canada had produced 3.8 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.95 MMT this year from 3.04 MMT last year. Farmer's bids are likely to increase from \$260 to \$305-335 per tonne due to good demand.
- **According to the trade sources, Burmese Tur crop** is in good condition and they are estimating around 3-3.5 Lakh MT productions this year. Buyers are asking \$1275(CNF) for January-February contract.
- **According to the local trader in Yangon, Urad stocks** at present may be around 3-4 thousand tones. At present contracts are at \$1825-1835 (FOB) for Fair Average Quality (FAQ).
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 1013 kilo tonnes which are around 82% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
