Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Continued steady to weak sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Friday.
- Due to all-time high prices in black pepper market, it is taking continuous corrections but still trading up by INR 2,300 per quintal from the same period last year on lower stocks.

Previous Update:

- Vietnam Pepper price today (November 10) stabilized again after yesterday's strong increase. As noted, the key provinces are purchasing pepper in the range of 58,500 62,000 VND/kg. In which, the lowest price of 58,500 VND/kg was recorded in Gia Lai province. Better than Dong Nai province with 59,000 VND/kg.
- The two provinces of Dak Lak and Dak Nong maintain the purchase of pepper at the same price of 60,000 VND/kg. Similarly, pepper prices today in Binh Phuoc and Ba Ria Vung Tau were also stable at 61,000 VND/kg and 62,000 VND/kg, respectively.

Previous Update:

• As per current situations, AgriWatch expected India's pepper productions for 2021-22 likely to go down by 8 to 10% compared to last year. Last year (2020-21) India's Pepper production was 62,000 MT.
