Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Continued steady to weak sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Wednesday.
- <u>Vietnam Pepper Price</u>: Vietnam Pepper price as on last trade remained stable in the range of 60,000-63,000 VND/kg in the domestic market. Currently, Gia Lai and Dong Nai are both recording the lowest price of 60,000 VND/kg. Next are the two provinces of Dak Lak and Dak Nong with the same price of 61,000 VND/kg. Similarly, pepper prices as on last trading day in Binh Phuoc and Ba Ria Vung Tau were also stable at 62,000 VND/kg and 63,000 VND/kg, respectively.

Previous Update:

• As per current situations, AgriWatch expected India's pepper productions for 2021-22 likely to go down by 8 to 10% compared to last year. Last year (2020-21) India's Pepper production was 62,000 MT.
