#### **Fundamentals:**

## **Today's Update:**

- Continued steady to weak sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Thursday.
- <u>Vietnam Pepper Price</u>: Vietnam Pepper price as on 7th December remained unchanged, traded in the range
  of 60,000-63,000 VND/kg in the domestic market. In which, the lowest price of 60,000 VND/kg is currently
  recorded in Gia Lai and Dong Nai provinces.
- The two provinces of Dak Lak and Dak Nong continue to purchase pepper at the same price of 61,000 VND/kg. Similarly, pepper prices today in Binh Phuoc and Ba Ria Vung Tau were also stable at 62,000 VND/kg and 63,000 VND/kg respectively.

### **Previous Update:**

• As per current situations, AgriWatch expected India's pepper productions for 2021-22 likely to go down by 8 to 10% compared to last year. Last year (2020-21) India's Pepper production was 62,000 MT.
