Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Continued steady sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Saturday.
- Vietnam Pepper prices as on last trade continued to be stable, anchored in the range of 57,500 60,000 VND/kg in key provinces. In which, the lowest price is currently 57,500 VND/kg in Gia Lai province. Dong Nai recorded a slightly higher price of 58,000 VND/kg.
- The two provinces of Dak Lak and Dak Nong maintain the purchase of pepper at the same price of 58,500 VND/kg.
- Similarly, pepper prices today in Binh Phuoc and Ba Ria Vung Tau were stable at 59,000 VND/kg and 60,000 VND/kg, respectively.

Previous Update:

• As per current situations, AgriWatch expected India's pepper productions for 2021-22 likely to go down by 8 to 10% compared to last year. Last year (2020-21) India's Pepper production was 62,000 MT.
