Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Steady to weak sentiment witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Saturday.
- Domestic pepper prices slowed down after the recent increase. As a result, the pepper market is stable and is holding the highest level at 67,000 VND/kg.
- The domestic pepper market's continuous decline in price in 2022 has had a significant impact on farmers' investment and care for this crop. The effects of climate change, pests and diseases, high prices of materials, fertilizers and labor also affect farmers' profits.

Previous Update:

As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
