Fundamentals:
Today's Update:

- Steady to firm sentiment witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Saturday.
- Pepper harvest season in Indonesia is observed between July and October each year. Presently, the country's pepper cultivation area has decreased by 25% from the 120,000 hectares recorded during the 1990s. Adverse weather conditions have impacted the yield and quality of pepper in Indonesia.
- As a consequence of consecutive droughts over many years and decreasing prices, Indonesia's crop production in 2023 is anticipated to be approximately 48,000 tonnes, which is lower than the previous year's production of 52,000 tonnes. Due to the low prices of pepper, black pepper farmers in Indonesia are shifting their focus to alternative crops such as rubber, cassava, and particularly palm oil.

Previous Update:

- Lower pepper supply reported as stockists were not interested to release their stocks as they are expecting higher prices in coming days supported the prices.
- As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
