

# **BLACK PEPPER**

### **Fundamentals:**

## Today's Update:

- Continued steady sentiment witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Monday.
- The prices of pepper in Vietnam as of March 13th remained steady in major provinces across the country. The local market saw pepper being traded between 63,500 - 66,000 VND/kg, with Gia Lai and Dong Nai provinces reporting prices of 63,500 VND/kg and 64,000 VND/kg respectively.
- Dak Lak and Dak Nong provinces also sustained the purchase of pepper at the consistent price of 64,500 VND/kg. Additionally, the prices of pepper in Binh Phuoc and Ba Ria Vung Tau provinces remained unaltered at 65,500 VND/kg and 66,000 VND/kg respectively.

#### Previous Update:

• As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
