Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Steady sentiment witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Thursday.
- As of March 29th, the prices of pepper in Vietnam's major provinces remained steady, with a trading range of 63,500 VND/kg to 66,000 VND/kg. Gia Lai had the lowest price at 63,500 VND/kg, surpassing Dong Nai with a price of 64,000 VND/kg. Pepper prices in Dak Lak and Dak Nong were trading at 64,500 VND/kg, while prices in Binh Phuoc and Ba Ria - Vung Tau remained stable at 65,500 VND/kg and 66,000 VND/kg, respectively.

Previous Update:

- World pepper production in 2023 is forecast around 539,850 Mt up from 521,000 Mt in 2022.
- As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
