

### BLACK PEPPER

**Fundamentals:**
**Today's Update:**

- Mixed sentiment witnessed in Black pepper spot market on Friday.
- Vietnam pepper prices as on 5th April simultaneously moved sideways in the range of 63,000 - 65,500 VND/kg in the domestic market.
- Currently, Gia Lai is the province with the lowest price with 63,000 VND/kg. In Dong Nai with the price of 63,500 VND/kg.
- The two provinces of Dak Lak and Dak Nong pepper traded at the price of 64,000 VND/kg.
- In Binh Phuoc and Ba Ria - Vung Tau traded at 65,000 VND/kg and 65,500 VND/kg.

**Previous Update:**

- World pepper production in 2023 is forecast around 539,850 Mt up from 521,000 Mt in 2022.
- As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
