Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Steady to firm sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot markets on Tuesday.
- Vietnam pepper prices as on 25th April 2023 traded in a range between 64,500 67,500 VND/kg. Specifically, the price of pepper in Dak Lak and Dak Nong today increased by 1,000 VND, to 66,000 VND/kg; in Gia Lai increased slightly by 500 dong, trading at 64,500 dong/kg; in Dong Nai also increased slightly and purchased at 65,000 VND/kg; in Ba Ria - Vung Tau increased slightly to 67,500 VND/kg; in Binh Phuoc pepper trading at VND 67,000/kg; after an increase of 1,000 dong. As per sources, increase in buying from export markets supported the prices.
- On April 25, the global pepper market remained steady with stable prices in various countries. In Indonesia, Lampung black pepper was priced at \$3,540/ton, while Muntok white pepper was traded at \$6,002/ton. Malaysia's Kuching ASTA black pepper was priced at \$4,900/ton and ASTA white pepper at \$7,300/ton. Meanwhile, in Brazil, black pepper ASTA 570 was priced at \$2,950/ton, and in Vietnam, the export prices of black pepper grades 500 and 550 g/l were at \$3,275 and \$3,325/ton, respectively. White pepper was priced at \$4,830/ton for export in Vietnam.

Previous Update:

- As per the Vietnam Pepper Association (VPA), approximately 70% of the pepper farming areas in Vietnam have already been harvested by mid-March 2023. Despite this, both planters and stockists are holding onto their pepper stocks instead of selling them immediately, as they anticipate higher prices in the near future. Some are only selling their stocks to meet their basic requirements.
- Sources suggest that pepper production in Vietnam has drastically reduced due to the decline in planting areas and crop losses. As a result, stockists are hoarding the remaining pepper stocks, expecting the prices to surge. Additionally, they are anticipating a surge in demand from China in the forthcoming days.
- World pepper production in 2023 is forecast around 539,850 Mt up from 521,000 Mt in 2022.
- As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
