Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Steady sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot markets on Saturday.
- Increased availability of imported pepper in the spot markets put pressure on domestic prices. Buyers are reported inactive in the spot markets due to continuous supply.
- During the period from January to April 2023, Vietnam remained the largest import market for pepper from Brazil, with a total import volume of 5,378 tons. This represents a slight increase of 0.5% compared to the same period last year. On the other hand, Brazil experienced a significant decline in pepper exports to the United States and Europe. Specifically, exports to the US decreased by 88.9%, while Germany saw a decline of 74.3%, and France experienced a decrease of 34.1%, among others.

Previous Update:

• As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
