

# **BLACK PEPPER**

#### **Fundamentals:**

## Today's Update:

- Continued steady to firm sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot markets on Tuesday.
- Lower supply in the spot markets supported the prices in the spot market.
- Vietnam Pepper price as on 4th July 2023 went sideways in the domestic market. Currently, pepper price trading at 66,500 70,000 VND/kg. In Gia Lai lowest price with 66,500 VND/kg. In Dong Nai, Dak Lak and Dak Nong, pepper is trading at 67,500 VND/kg. Similarly, pepper prices in Binh Phuoc and Ba Ria Vung Tau are also traded at 69,000 VND/kg and 70,000 VND/kg respectively.

### **Previous Update:**

- Increased availability of imported pepper in the spot markets put pressure on domestic prices. Buyers are reported inactive in the spot markets due to continuous supply.
- As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
