Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Steady to firm sentiment was witnessed in Black pepper spot markets on Monday.
- On improved export demand due to upcoming festivals, prices reported firm today and it is expected that market prices and supply will trade on higher side on improved demand this month.
- According to the Import-Export Department of the Ministry of Industry and Trade in Vietnam, the estimated figures for June 2023 indicate a decrease in pepper exports by 13.6% in volume compared to the same month in 2022. However, there was a 3.4% increase in volume compared to June 2022. In the period from January to June 2023, Vietnam's pepper exports reached an estimated 156,000 tonnes, showing a significant increase of 26.6% in volume compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
- During June 2023, the average export price of Vietnamese pepper was estimated at \$3,667 per tonne. This reflects an 18.1% increase compared to May 2023 but a decline of 11.3% when compared to June 2022. Similarly, for the first six months of the current year, the average export price of Vietnam's pepper was estimated at \$3,184 per tonne. This represents a significant decrease of 29.7% when compared to the same period in 2022.
- As of July 17th, 2023, the prices of pepper in the domestic market of Vietnam have remained relatively stable, showing sideways movement on a significant scale. Currently, the trading range for pepper is between 67,000 VND/kg and 70,000 VND/kg. In Gia Lai province, the recorded price stands at 67,000 VND/kg, while in Dong Nai province, it is slightly higher at 67,500 VND/kg. Dak Lak and Dak Nong provinces have seen pepper being traded at 68,000 VND/kg. Similarly, in Binh Phuoc province, the price is 69,000 VND/kg, and in Ba Ria Vung Tau, it is 70,000 VND/kg.

Previous Update:

• As per current situation, AgriWatch expects India's pepper production for 2022-23 likely to be around 52,000 to 53,000 MT. Last year production was 57,000 to 58,000 MT.
