

## Castor Daily Fundamental Report 9th Feb, 2015

### **Castor Domestic Fundamentals:**

- Cash seed market traded weak on Saturday on sluggish trading activities. Downtrend in major markets continued. Market declined by Rs 50 per quintal in these markets. However, slight recovery was seen in markets like Patan and Ahmedabad. Overall sentiments remain bearish.
- Korea emerged as top buyer of castor meal in the month of January, importing 5327.33 tonne, followed by Taiwan with 4791.87 tonne. Besides, Japan, France and USA imported lower quantity in the month of January. As per the latest IBIS update total castor meal export during this period recorded at 12786 tonne. Export volume is likely to improve in the month of Feb with higher seed supply and declining prices in the seed market.
- FMC, the market regulator's attempt to check abnormal fluctuation and unexpected huge open interest with 100 percent margin bore fruits to some extent. The highest delivery was registered in jan-2015 on the NCDEX. Recently it had directed the exchange to make advance staggered delivery in castor seed and coriander. Resultantly, delivery started from 19th Dec instead of pre set date from 11th Jan.It had levied 100 percent margin from December 26th,2014.
- Because of this action stock increased from 205,000 tonne to 430,000 tonne in one month. Open interest too reduced from 346,000 tonne to 36,000 tonne during this period. In Jan total delivery was recorded at 203000 tonne
- Castor seed in Gujarat decreased by 1750 per tonne in comparison to last week from Rs43000 to Rs 41250 per tonne. It is lower by Rs 1208 per tonne from the price realised on Jan 2014. Castor meal in bulk volume for export at Kandla is being quoted at \$132 per tonne. FOB quote at Kandla decreased considerably from \$1410 per tonne to \$1395 per tonne during the week under review. It is likely to rule in the range of \$1390 to \$1400 in the month of February.

### International Market Update:

- Some fresh buying interest has been reported at \$1390 per tonne for castor oil at Kandla Port. Buyers are interested to buy at \$1380/1390 per tonne. As seed is under pressure dip in oil price seems to be on card.
- Castor meal demand may improve as availability of meal around \$125/128 seems possible in the weeks ahead with higher seed availability for crushing. It is being traded at \$132 per tonne at kandla. Bulk buying is expected in March –April, the peak arrival season and likely lower price.

**Domestic market Outlook:** Market is likely to trade lower.
