

Highlights of the Week

Mixed trend are continued in Karnataka market on ups and down in demand during this week ended as on 11th May 2015. Arabica Parchment is registered at 10150 in Rs./50 kg bags which is lower than last week price i.e. 10100 in Rs./50 kg bags. As per sources, Starbucks Corp has locked in prices on 70 per cent of 2016 coffee needs at "favorable" levels when compared to its 2015 coffee costs.

As per recently released data by the Coffee Board Of India, Coffee Planted area of Karnataka, Kerala, Tamilnadu stood at 230333 hectares, 85359 hectares, 31544 hectares respectively followed by Arabica planted area by 109003 hectares, 4175 hectares, 25939 hectares and Robusta planted area by 121330 hectares, 81184 hectares, 5605 hectares respectively in 2013/14 against 213386 hectares, 84413 hectares, 29996 hectares in 2012/13. Total coffee area of India is covered near at 418975 hectares in 2013/14 higher than 415341 hectares in 2012/13.

DGCIS report, India has received total coffee exports revenue around Rs. 659.05 crore which is in USD 105.53 million in March 2015 higher by 2.58% in Rs. and 0.22% in USD respectively against Rs. 642.45 crore and USD 105.30 million respectively in previous year during the same month. It stood at Rs. 4906.36 crore and the value in USD at 802.96 million since April-2014 to March-2015 up by 2.24 in Rs. and 0.52% when the value is counting in USD against last year revenue i.e. Rs.4799.10 crore and in USD 798.83 million in corresponding period of time.

According to Indonesian Coffee Exporters and Industries Association, coffee exports of Indonesia in March-2015 stood higher by 73% to 20,246.26 tonnes against 14038.07 tonnes in previous month on good demand. Total 221242.6 tonnes of coffee is exported by Indonesia in 2014 lower from 355771.20 tonnes in 2013. Total coffee exports quantity may fall to 350,000 tonnes in 2015 against 382,774 tonnes of last year end.

As per sources, coffee output of Indonesia is expected to decline to between 650,000 and 700,000 tonnes in 2015 as compared to 711,513 tonnes in 2014 due to adverse weather condition.

As per ICO, Brazil shipped total 36.8 million 60-kg bags of coffee in the 2014/15 crop year, through end-March 2015 with an increase of 12.4% from the 32.7 million bags exported in 2013/14 on account of lower production volume due to the drought in early 2014 and domestic consumption of 21 million bags. This would suggest that significant volumes of domestic stocks have been used to supply the market over the last year.



Exports and Imports of India

Provisional Indian green coffee exports is registered down by 17.01% to 96088 metric tonnes from 1st January 2015 to 7th May 2015 as compared to 115795 metric tonnes of previous year exports during the same period of time. India re-exports maximum Instant type of coffee which is recorded down at 57.22% to 7058 metric tonnes in this year during 1st January 2015 to 7th May 2015 from preceding year instant coffee volume i.e. 16501 metric tonnes. Total provisional exports of Arabica parchment, Arabica cherry is placed down by 41.51% to 17273, 30.20% to 5869 metric tonnes respectively against last year exports volume i.e. 29532 metric tonnes, 8409 metric tonnes respectively in the same period of time.

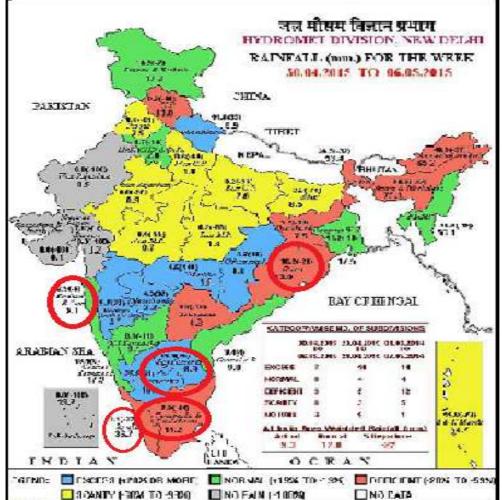

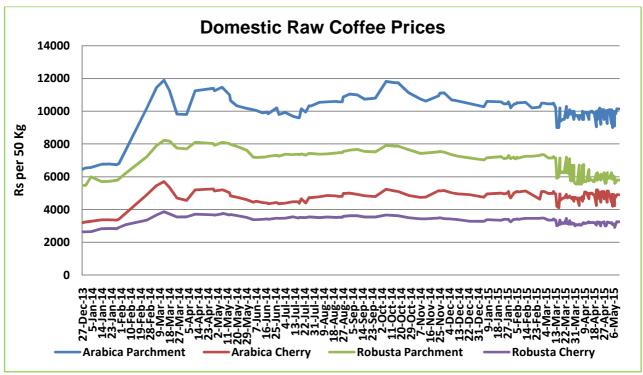

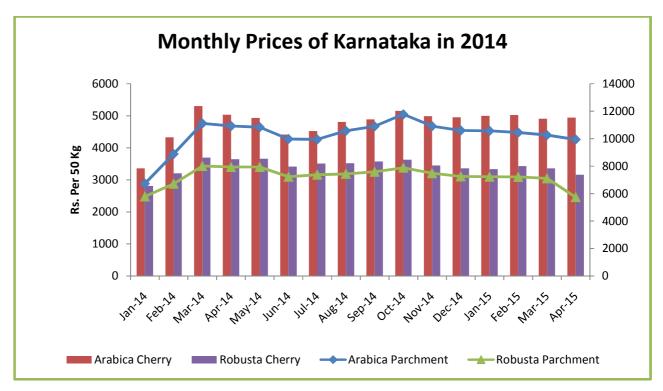


Coffee Prices of Auction Market & State-wise Market

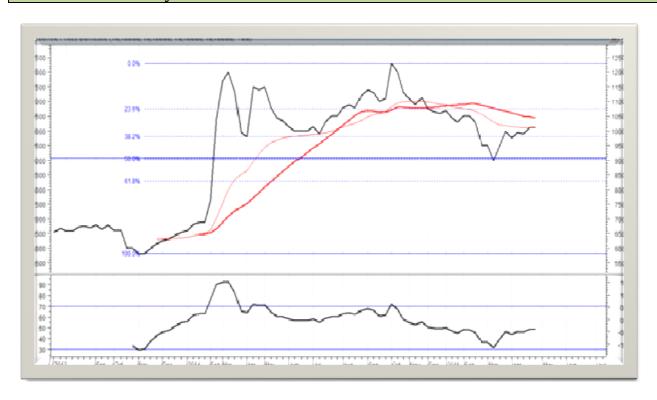

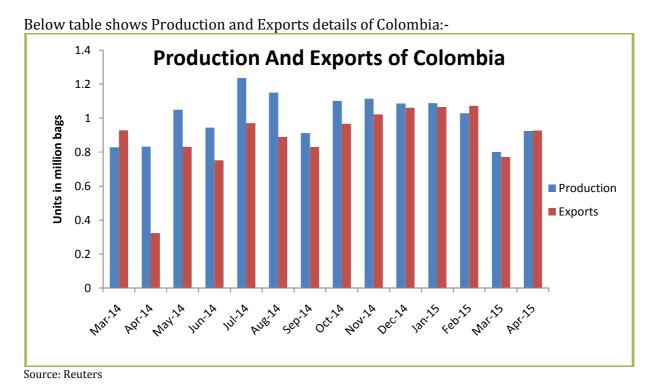
International Market Updates:

Weekly Futures Review -

ICE Arabica coffee future prices of July contract increased by 2% to 134.65 USC cents per Ib from 131.70 USC cents per Ib due to buyers interests in the market during this week. While Robusta coffee prices on Liffe stood 2% higher at 1758 USD/T in the current week against 1718 USD/T in the last week.

Brazil:- According to traders ,Brazil's crop supply agency Conab has scheduled a new auction to sell old crop Arabica coffees a week on May 13, as the country's coffee belt prepares to enter the peak of harvest. New crop coffees will not likely hit the open market for at least a month or more as producers harvest, cure and transport the beans to port or cooperative. Brazil's Robusta harvest started in April but the larger Arabica harvest is just getting started in some isolated areas. The bulk of the Arabica harvest is not likely to occur until June. Conab sold 28,000 bags of old crop coffee on April 30 in its last auction. It was the first successful auction of federally warehoused coffee in years. The volume of coffee sold in the previous and next week's auction is insufficient to affect market prices. The older beans are used in blends by roasters primarily.

Colombia:- According to Reuters, Colombia produces 15.5% higher coffee to 0.924 million bags in April 2015 as compared to 0.927 million bags in last month. Colombia exports total 0.927 million bags in April 2015 with an increase of 20.07% against March month exports volume i.e. 0772 million bags.

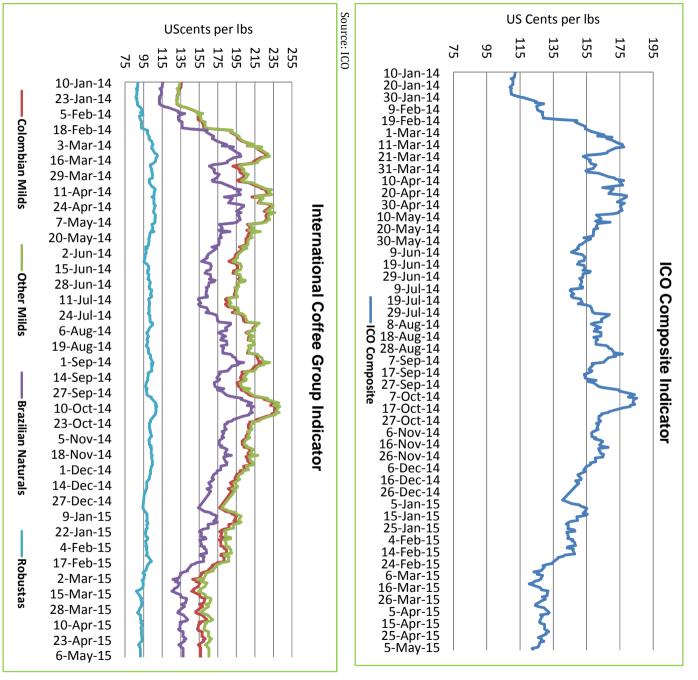
