

Executive Summary

Domestic Coffee Market Summary

Domestic coffee prices slumped in Karnataka physical market, as on 27th February 2016 supported by a slow and steady new demand. Indian coffee exports is likely to surge supported by weak Rupee and good output of Robusta crop despite reports of excessive supply in the global market. So far, coffee harvesting of both the varieties is finished however farmers are not willing to release their stocks in full swing in expectation of higher prices in future. The prices have gone below the cost of production, particularly in the case of Arabica, as the wages and other expenses have increased.

As per the Coffee Board of India, provisional Indian green coffee exports from 1st January 2016 to 24th February 2016 is registered higher by 17.67% at 36057 metric tons compared to 30640 metric tons exported during the corresponding period of previous year. India re-exports maximum Instant type of coffee, which is recorded higher by 4.68% at 3086 metric tons in this year during 1st January 2016 to 24th February 2016 from preceding year instant coffee volume i.e.2948 metric tons. Total provisional exports of Arabica parchment and Robusta Cherry is placed higher by 43.05% at 9386, 22.71% at 19639 metric tons respectively against exports volume of 6561 metric tons, 16004 metric tons respectively in the corresponding period of last year. However, Arabica cherry is placed lower at 1906 metric tonnes with a decline of 26.26% and Robusta parchment at 1997 metric tonnes with a decline of 20.71%.

Recommendation:

Weekly Call - : Market participants are advised to go short above 8250 levels for a target of 8075 and 7802 with a stop loss at 8512 on closing basis.

International Coffee Market Summary

As per sources, Uganda shipped 334,393 60-kg bags of coffee in January 2016 compared with 310,149 bags shipped in same month a year ago. The National Coffee Association of Guatemala have reported that the countries coffee exports for the month of January were 8,641 bags or 4.34% lower than the same month last year, at a total of 190,307 bags. This figure contributes to the countries cumulative coffee exports for the first four months of this new October 2015 to September 2016 coffee year to being 29,965 bags or 7.46% higher than the same period in the previous coffee year, at a total of 431,699 bags. It is still early days for the new crop in Guatemala, but the positive start to this coffee years export performance does seemingly indicate that with the new crop harvest in progress, that the forecasts for and approximately 7% larger new crop might have some reality.

As per, Agriculture ministry's crop supply agency Conab, Brazil will auction roughly 188,000 bags of Arabica coffee from government stocks. The government, which is in need of revenues to cover a growing budget shortfall, has been trying to sell - largely unsuccessfully - some of the 1.5 million 60-kg bags of Arabica coffee that it holds in public stocks. The coffee was acquired from producers during the 2009/2010 harvest and is mostly green to yellow, hard cup, with 26 to 86 defects. It currently sits stacked in Conab warehouses across the coffee belt. Conab has been holding regular coffee auctions from public stocks since late in 2015 but all except the last one earlier in early February flopped due to high minimum prices that the market snubbed. Even the last auction only sold a fraction of the bags on offer.

As per ICO report, coffee consumption of the World in 2014 was revised higher by 0.3% to 150.2 million 60-kg bags followed by higher consumption in exporting countries mainly in Asia. The revision means global consumption by an average 2.5 percent annually between 2011 and 2014. ICO forecasted total coffee global output for the season 2015/16 at 143.4 million bags with an increase of 1.4% against last year record.

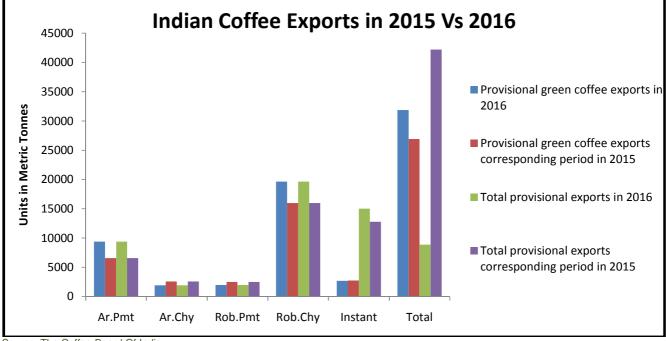

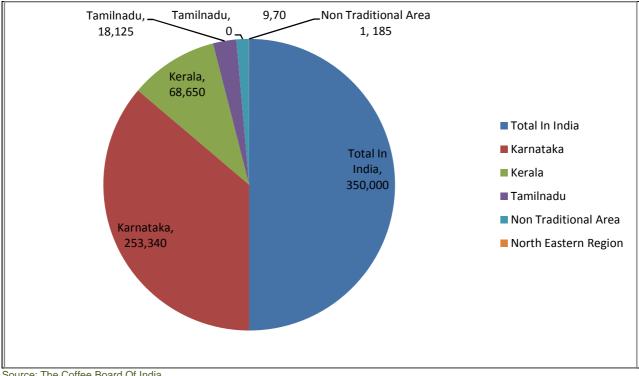

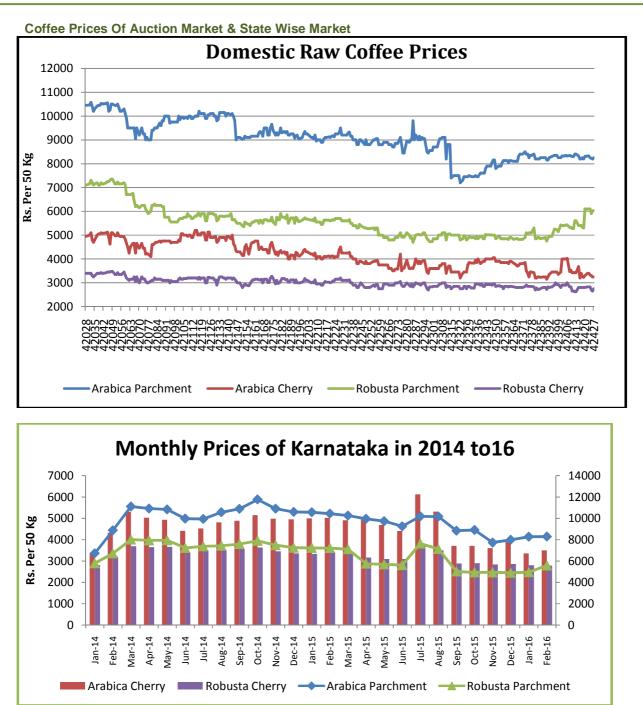

<u>Vietnam:-</u> According to Vietnam Customs data, coffee exports in the first half of February went up by 24.5 percent from a year ago to 37,600 tonnes. Coffee growers in Vietnam have been holding on to stocks, expecting higher prices. Traders are expecting prices to rise as Central Highlands coffee belt could face drought in coming months which will affect Robusta production. Coffee growers, who have been watering trees for the next 2016/2017 crop cycle, are not in a rush to unload stocks as prices have fallen below production costs.

Indonesia:- According to the government data, Robusta coffee exports fell by 30% to 8418.8 tonnes in January 2016 as compared to 12046.3 tonnes of December 2015. Indonesia exported total 17653.3 tonnes of Robusta in January 2016. Indonesia's full-year exports for 2015 to 269,113.18 tonnes, up 22 percent from 221,242.55 tonnes

<u>Brazil:</u> As per Brazil's Trade Ministry, Brazil shipped total 2485113 60 kg bags in January 2016 lower by 17% against 2976727 60 kg bags in December 2015.Below table shows Brazil's Coffee Exports details:-

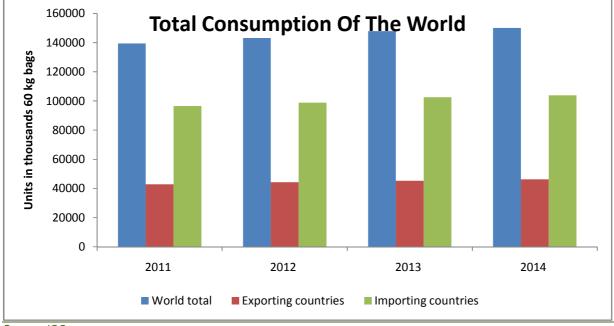

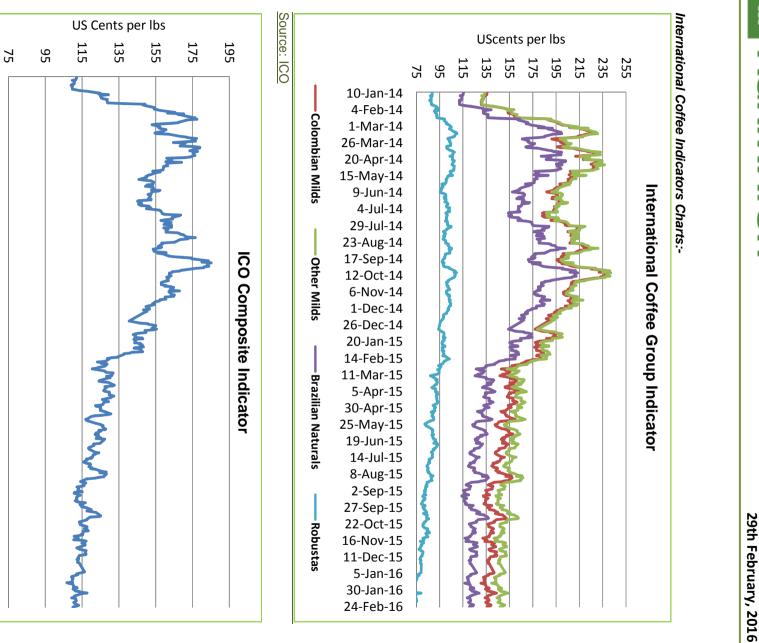
