

COFFEE WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 21st March, 2016

Executive Summary

Domestic Coffee Market Summary

Domestic coffee prices slumped in Karnataka physical market, as on 19th March 2016 on sluggish demand. Domestic beans demand is very low as of now. Indian traders and farmers hold remaining 10% old stocks in hand. Coffee trees are standing on flowering stage. Most of the Robusta coffee plants are irrigated artificially. However, Arabica trees need rainfall. If the existing dry weather continues, it may harm flowers of Robusta trees and productivity maybe affected for the next season. During March month, volatile domestic prices indicate price rise in the first week of this month and lowering in the second week. Overall differences in the domestic coffee prices ranged between Rs. 50 to 100 /60 kg bag in raw form, but we saw good improvement of around Rs 500 only with Robusta parchment price momentum.

As per the Coffee Board of India, provisional Indian green coffee exports from 1st January 2016 to 16th March 2016 is registered higher by 31.01% at 57737 metric tons compared to 47216 metric tons exported during the corresponding period of previous year. India re-exports maximum Instant type of coffee. Instant Coffee export between 1st January 2016 to 16th March 2016 this year, is recorded higher by 15.79% at 4590 metric tons from preceding year volume of 3964 metric tons. Total provisional exports of Arabica parchment and Robusta Cherry is placed higher by 31.01% at 12580, 35.64% at 33436 metric tons respectively against exports volume of 9602 metric tons, 24650 metric tons respectively in the corresponding period of last year. However, Arabica cherry is placed lower at 2723 metric tonnes with a decline of 22.02% and Robusta parchment at 4354 metric tonnes with a decline of 20.21%.

Recommendation:

Weekly Call -: Market participants are advised to stay away due to volatility in the market.

International Coffee Market Summary

As per Vietnam's custom data, Vietnam shipped lower coffee exports by 30.1% to 119,000 tonnes (1.98 million 60 kg bags) in February 2016. While, total coffee exports volume during Oct 2015 to February 2016 (the first five months) is registered 20.2% high at 634,300 tonnes of the season 2015/16. Traders had forecast coffee exports in the holiday-shortened February at 90,000-100,000 tonnes, while the government estimated the monthly shipment at 120,000 tonnes. Due to dry weather condition and higher global prices, domestic coffee sale of Vietnam surged while exporters have not rushed to sell to foreign buyers. As per sources, the dry season has entered its peak in Vietnam's Central Highlands coffee belt, affecting nearly a fifth of the coffee farms and rainy season is expected to begin after 10 to 15 days.

According to ICO report, world's coffee exports in January 2016 went down by 0.8% to 9.04 million bags as compared to January 2015 exports value i.e. 8.96 million bags. While, total exports for the first four months of the coffee year (October to January in 2015/16) are slightly up 1.7% on 35.9 million bags against 35.25. Exports from Brazil have started to slowdown, with January shipments down by 10.2% at 2.74 million bags compared to last year record volume of 3.05 million bags due to thin stockpiles, although this is still a significant volume of coffee. Vietnam's coffee exports are placed up by 10.1% at 2.25 million bags against 2.04 million bags in January 2015. Colombia continues to export higher volumes i.e.1.09 million bags in January 2016 with an increase of 38% from 1.05 million bags during corresponding period of last year, with production levels for the first third of the crop year already on 5.3 million bags.



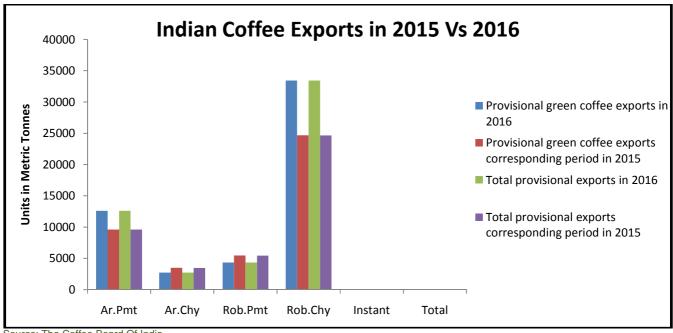

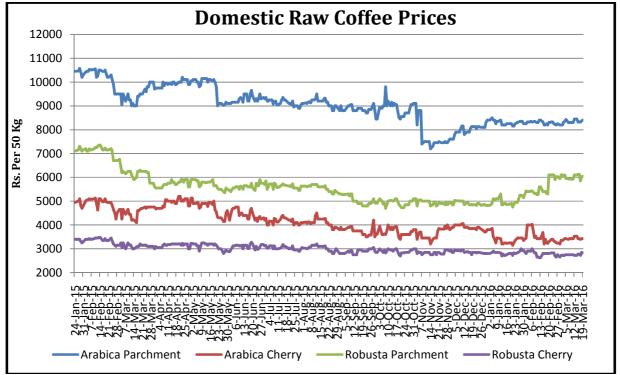

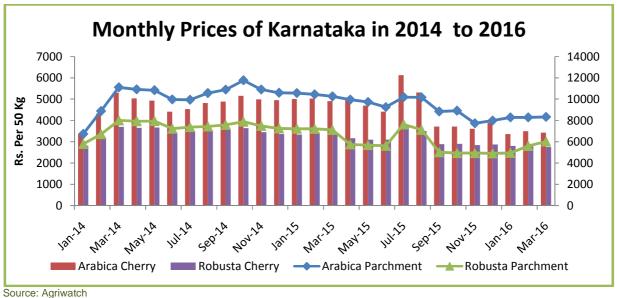

International Market Updates

ICE coffee future prices closed at 127.40 cents/lb significantly higher by 5.64% in this week against 120.60 cents/lb of the last week. As per RTRS, ICE certified stocks went down by 5817 to 1,445,818 bags as on 17th March 2016 against 1,454,683 bags as on 16th March, 2016. As per the Green Coffee Association, U.S. green coffee went up by 33981 bags to 5.9 million 60 kg bags by the end of February 2016.

Indonesia: As per sources, Indonesia may face dryer than normal weather in several fire and haze- prone regions in western and central area in March and April 2016 on account of smoldering fires, often set deliberately to clear land for palm oil plantations on Sumatra and Borneo islands.

According to the government data, Robusta coffee exports fell by 55.68% to 9896.08 tonnes in February 2016 compared to 8418.8 tonnes in January 2016. Indonesia exported total 18314.88 tonnes of Robusta in 2016 so far. It shipped 47.91% in February 2016 compared to the volume of 18999 tonnes in February 2015.

World Scenario:-

- 1) As per the Nairobi Coffee Exchange the highest price of Kenya's benchmark grade AA coffee declined at this week's auction from the previous sale. The East African country produces high-quality coffee, which is in huge demand from roasters worldwide, and used to blend with beans from other countries.
- 2) As per ICO, world coffee consumption is registered at 152.10 million bags in 2015 higher from 150.3 million in 2014. The average annual growth rate over the last four years remains at a healthy 2%. Demand in the European Union, has stagnated slightly at an estimated 42 million bags, averaging growth of 0.8% per year since 2012, but the USA continues to show an increased appetite for coffee, increasing by an average rate of 3.2% to an estimated 24.4 million bags. Japan also continues to expand, averaging 2.4% growth to 7.6 million bags. As a result, total consumption in all importing countries is estimated at 104.9 million bags. Consumption growth in Brazil has slowed to an average of 0.5%, but remains high on 20.5 million bags. Much of the recent growth has come from Asia, with Indonesia, the Philippines, India and Thailand all growing at between 4.5 and 9%. Hence, total consumption in exporting countries is estimated at 47.3 million bags, at an average annual growth rate of 2.3% over the last four years.

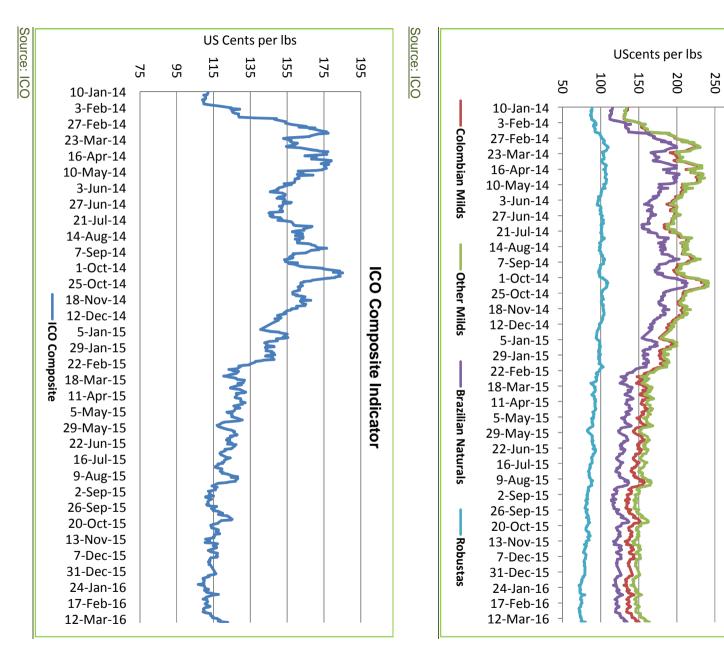
