

COFFEE WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 11th April, 2016

Executive Summary

Domestic Coffee Market Summary

Higher tone witnessed in Karnataka physical market, as on 9th April 2016 on slight improved demand. Approx 20 to 30% old stocks are available with sellers. Robusta plants are growing as flowering stage. However, Arabica is yet to flower needs showers to further grow. Now a days the weather in the south belt in India is very hot. There is fires in many places of coffee belts. Further dryness will hamper growth of the coffee beans and new shoots of branches will be stunned. Buyers are awaiting a further fall in the prices. New blossom of Robusta coffee opened during Feb 2016 while Arabica coffee plants are awaiting rains for flowering by May 2016. Most of the Robusta coffee plants are irrigated artificially.

As per the Coffee Board of India, provisional Indian green coffee exports from 1st January 2016 to 5th April 2016 is registered higher by 24.96% at 80785 metric tons compared to 64645 metric tons exported during the corresponding period of previous year. India re-exports maximum Instant type of coffee. Instant Coffee export between 1st January 2016 to 5th April 2016 this year, is recorded higher by 2.59% at 5735 metric tons from preceding year volume of 5590 metric tons. Total provisional exports of Arabica parchment and Robusta Cherry is placed higher by 32.16% at 16459 and 41.05% at 47521 metric tons respectively against exports volume of 12521 metric ton and 33690 metric tons respectively in the corresponding period of last year. However, Arabica cherry is placed lower at 4020 metric tonnes with a decline of 2.02% as one of the main buyers ILLIcafe has reduced its volume for Arabica cherry and Robusta parchment at 6892 metric tonnes with a decline of 20.27%.

Recommendation:

Weekly Call -: Market participants are advised to go short at the current price level in the market. Market are expected to perform downside even in the week ahead too.

International Coffee Market Summary

According to IBGE federal statistics institute of Brazil, Brazil may produce 50.2 million 60 kg bags coffee crop which is higher by 1% from its March forecast of 49.7 million bags including Arabica coffee crop size at 39.2 million bags against 38.9 million bags forecast in March 2016. On the other hand, Brazil's Robusta crop size is placed at 11 million bags versus 10.8 million bags forecast in March. Total domestic consumption of Brazil stood approx 20 million and 21 million bags with export market dedicated demand for Brazil coffees of approximately 32 million bags. Harvesting of Robusta (Conilon) is under process with the new Arabica coffee harvest due to start as early as May but with volumes only picking up during June and July. Carryover stocks including two years volume is almost finished so far.

As per sources, Honduras shipped total 762,333 60 kg bags in March 2016 down by 2.9% from 784,929 60 kg bags in the year earlier period. Honduras is likely to export about 5.52 million bags this season, or 10 percent more than the last. Shipment of Honduras went up by4.3% to 2.47 million bags so far compared to the same six-month period in the previous 2014/2015 harvesting season. Costa Rica exported higher coffee beans up by 6.4% to 488,132 60-kg bags during the six months of the 2015/16 season. While, total coffee exports of Costa Rica in March month is recorded higher at 175,447 bags from 164,967 60-kg bags during the same month last season.

Vietnam's coffee premium surged on tight supply and lower stocks in Indonesia supported to higher premium of coffee. A drought caused by the El Nino weather pattern in Vietnam's Central Highlands coffee belt, which raised concerns about the next 2016/2017 crop output, could weaken late this month or in May 2016 when rainfall returns to the region. After this news, farmers started to hold their stocks in expectation of further boost in prices. On account of drought condition, Central Highlands coffee belt suffers total of 40,000 hectares of the planting area of this season. As per traders, Vietnam is likely to export total 140,000 -150,000 tonne(2.33-2.50 million 60 kg bags) of coffee beans in April 2016 after shipping an estimated 160,000 tonnes in March 2016.





International Market Updates

ICE coffee future prices closed on weak note .It is down by 6% to 119.80 cents/lb in this week against 127.45 cents/lb of the last week. As per RTRS, ICE certified stocks decreased by 393 to1416864 bags as on 8th April 2016 against 1417257 bags as on 07th April, 2016. As per CFTC, ICE coffee speculators cut net long position 10307 contract to 8,760 in week to April 5,2016.

Colombia:- According to the National Coffee Growers' Federation, Colombia's production of washed Arabica coffee beans declined by 13.86% to 944000 tonnes 60-kg bags in March 2016 compared to 109600 tonnes in February 2016. While, total production of Colombia is registered higher by 18% in March 2015 against 800000 tonnes 60-kg bags in March 2015. This improved performance has contributed to the countries cumulative production for the first six months of this new October 2015 to September 2016 coffee year to being 1,101,000 bags or 17.7% higher than the same period in the previous coffee year, at a total of 7,320,000 bags. It exported total 1.08 million bags in March 2016 with a decline of 2.26% compared to last month i.e.1.105 million bags. However, It is higher by 39.89% from 0.772 million bags a year ago during the corresponding period of time. This improved performance has contributed to the countries cumulative exports for the first six months of this new October 2015 to September 2016 coffee year to being 803,000 bags or 13.49% higher than the same period in the previous coffee year, at a total of 6,756,000 bags.

Others:-

A) As per the Nairobi Coffee exchange, the highest price of Kenya's benchmark grade AA coffee went down at this week's auction compared with the previous sale. The East African country produces high-quality coffee, which roasters use to blend with beans from other countries.

B) As per sources, El Salvador exported lower coffee beans by 38.9 percent to 53480 60 kg bags in February 2016 against 87597 60 kg bags in the corresponding month last year due to lower international market prices. El Salvador, one of Central America's smaller coffee producers, had been one of the hardest hit by the spread of Roya, also known as coffee leaf rust, over the past couple of seasons. The coffee season in Central America and Mexico, which together produce more than a fifth of the world's Arabica beans, runs from October through September.




