



Executive Summary

Domestic Coffee Market Summary

Mixed trend were featured in Karnataka physical market during this week, as on 30th June 2016 due to ups and downs in arrivals and demand. Coffee prices are rising on account of BREXIT. India receives good rainfall which will be beneficial to grow coffee beans. Arabica picking in India is likely to start in November 2016. As per Indian government data, India's main reservoirs receives the water level at 15% of their storage capacity in the week to June 30,2016 while down 17 percentage points from a year earlier. The latest levels were lower than the last 10 years' average i.e. 22 percent, but remained unchanged against last week. Monsoon arrived at India's southern Kerala coast on June 8, a day later than forecast, however rain is likely to pick up in July 2016.

As per the Coffee Board of India, provisional Indian green coffee exports from 1st January 2016 to 30thvJune 2016 is registered higher by 26.90% at 29592 metric tons compared to 23319 metric tons exported during the corresponding period of previous year. India re-exports maximum Instant type of coffee. Instant Coffee export from 1st January 2016 to 30th June 2016 this year, recorded down by 4.57% at 12578 metric tons from preceding year volume of 13181 metric tons. Total provisional exports of Arabica parchment and Robusta Cherry is placed higher by 26.90% at 29592 and 35.19% at 99675 metric tons respectively against exports volume of 23319 metric ton and 73727 metric tons respectively in the corresponding period of last year. However, Arabica cherry is placed lower at 8029 metric tonnes with a decline of 1.54% and Robusta parchment to 16310 metric tonnes with a decline of 22.95%.

Recommendation:

Weekly Call -: Market participants are advised to go long on the current level for short period of time.

International Coffee Market Summary

According to ICO report, Coffee exports of the World slipped by 6.8 percent in May 2016 from the same month last year to total 9.32 million 60-kg bags followed by Robusta coffee exports which stood at 3.37 million bags with a decline of 9.6% and Arabica coffee exports stood down by 5.1% to 5.95 million bags in May 2016. For the first eight months of the 2015/16 season, which began on Oct. 1 last year, coffee exports were up 1.6 percent at 75.95 million bags. Robusta coffee exports fell 9.6 percent in May from a year earlier to 3.37 million bags followed by Robusta coffee exports i.e. 27.53 million bags down by 5.1% and Arabica coffee exports volume which stood higher by 6.0% to 48.42 million bags.

As per sources, Brazil shipped total 2.06 Million 60 kg bags of coffee in June compared to 2.17 million bags in May 2016 and 2.39 million bags a year ago in the corresponding period of time. As per Cooxupe, Brazil has harvested 25.7 pct of the 2016/2017 crop which is higher than last year record i.e.15.5 pct of the harvested crop, and in 2014, 35.5 pct had been harvested. As per coop said recently that as much as 30 pct of the crop had been knocked to the ground by rains over the past month, which would cause the loss in quality in the beans. According to market forecaster, Brazil's current coffee crop is estimated to be between 50 million and 60 million 60-kg bags.

As per sources, Vietnam, the world's largest Robusta producer, is likely to ship total 160,000 tonnes (2.67 million 60-kg bags) of coffee in June 2016 with an increase of 45.8 percent against last year record. The June shipments will bring the country's coffee exports so far in the 2015/2016 season to 1.32 million tonnes, up 32 percent from a year ago. Traders in Vietnam expected the exports volume of the country in the range of 150,000 and 170,000 tonnes of Coffee in June 2016. The coffee crop year runs from October to September in Vietnam, which ranks behind Brazil in overall coffee output.

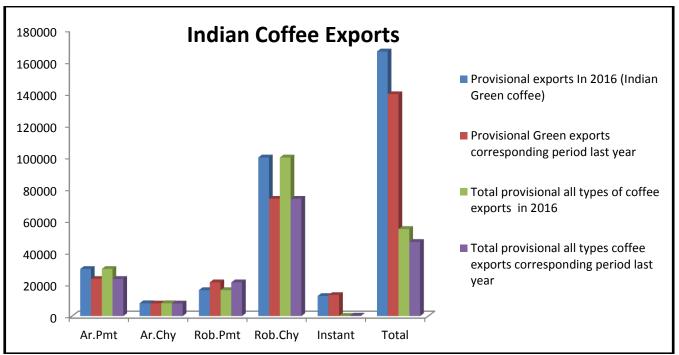

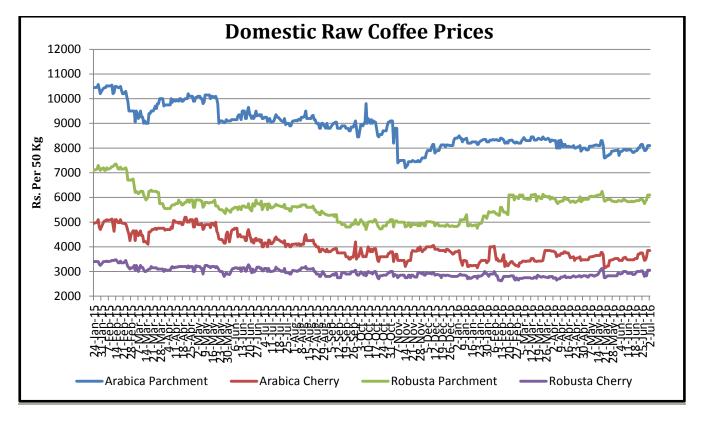

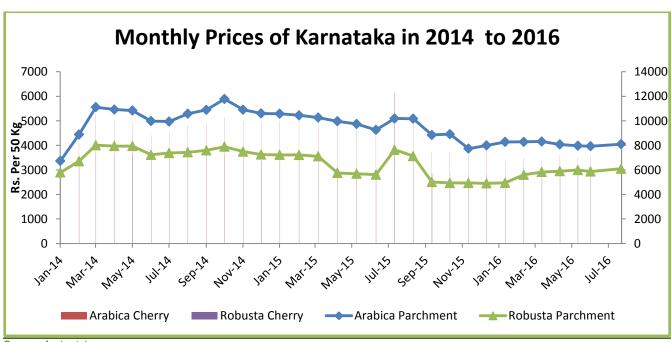

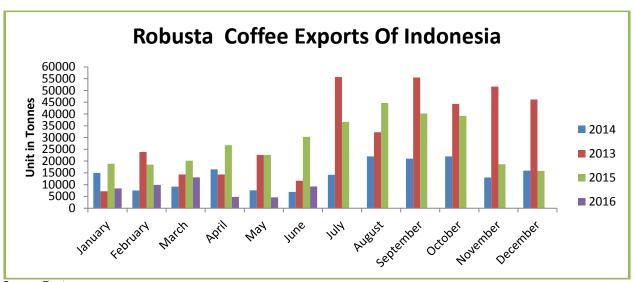


International Market Updates

ICE coffee future prices surged by 4.02% to 144.85 cents/lb in this week against 139.25 cents/lb of the last week. As per RTRS, ICE certified stocks declined by 1575 bags to 1,304,181 bags as on July 1,2016 against 1,305,756 bags as on June 30,2016. Speculators increased their net long position in Arabica coffee by 2037 to 29036 contracts.

Indonesia:-

According to the government trade data, Sumatra main growing area of Indonesia shipped lower Robusta coffee beans by 69.46% to 9255.6 tonnes in June 2016 as compared to last year record volume i.e. 30314.60 tonnes in the same month. Shipment of Indonesia went up by 99.61% against 4637.2 tonnes of May month exports volume. Below table shows Coffee exports details of Indonesia:-

Others:-

1) The National Coffee Institute IHCAFE, Honduras shipped lower coffee beans by 18.5 percent in June compared with the period last year prompting exporters to cut their forecasts for foreign shipments this season. Relatively, Central America's top coffee exporter declined at 592,530 60-kg bags in June 2016 against 726,893 60-kg bags in the same month last year. Honduras is likely to export 5.52 million 60-kg bags this season compared with 5.02 million in the 2014-2015 cycle. The coffee season in Central America and Mexico, which together produce about a fifth of the world's Arabica beans, runs from October through September. Honduras, Central America and Mexico is recovering from the Roya blight.

2) As per sources, Ivory Coast exported coffee bean totalled 29,221 tonnes in the five months to end May, up nearly 56 percent on the same period last year. Below table depicts port data for coffee beans exports:-

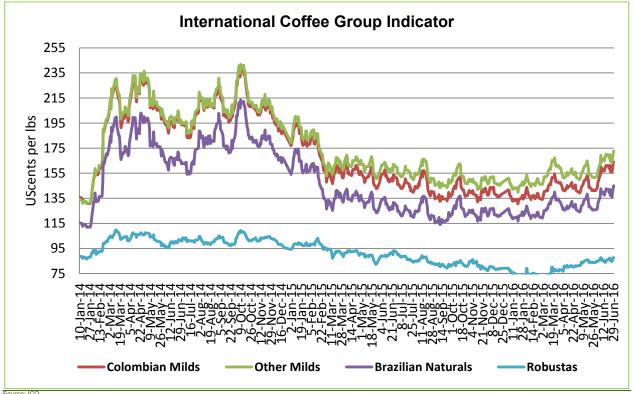

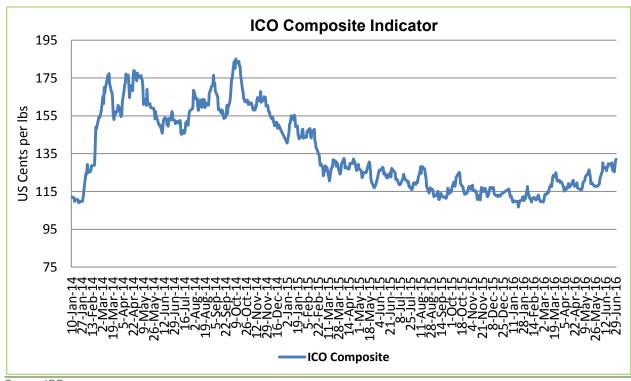
