

Executive Summary Domestic Coffee Market Summary

Karnataka physical market extended its high trend as on 22nd Sep 2016 on improved demand. Overall demand is very slow in the market as prices are very high due to higher international market. Exporters are trying to finish their earlier commitments—as the markets seem to rise. It is raining in small showers in the coffee belts of India. Farmers and traders of India expect a fall in Robusta crops production by 15 to 20% despite good monsoon. Price as of now seem to be heading higher and may remain volatile, due to shortage of crop internationally.

As per the Coffee Board of India, provisional Indian green coffee exports to 1st January 2016 to 22nd September 2016 is registered higher by 15.68 % at 221321 metric tons compared to 191310 metric tons exported to the corresponding period of previous year. India re-exports maximum Instant of coffee. Instant Coffee exports to 1st January 2016 to 22nd September 2016 this year, recorded down by 19.36% at 18310 metric tons from preceding year volume of 22708 metric tons. Total provisional exports of Arabica parchment, Arabica Cherry and Robusta Cherry is placed higher by 25.89 at 38984, 7.03% to 9174 metric tonnes and 30.58% at 135670 metric tons respectively from 1st January to 22nd September against exports volume of 27789 metric ton, 8571 metric tonnes and 103892 metric tons respectively in the corresponding period of last year. However, Robusta parchment is registered lower for 22989 metric tonnes with a decline 18.18%. Coffee exports volume may rise in upcoming months due to continuous rainfall in Vietnam, one of the largest producer of Robusta beans.

Recommendation:

Weekly Call -: Market participants are advised to go long on the current level for short period.

International Coffee Market Summary

As per a poll of industry insider, Brazil is likely to harvest a bumper coffee crop at 54.9 million bags in 2016/17 season because of dry weather condition which has yielded good quality beans than previous year. Other sources like traders, exporters keeps coffee crop estimates in the range between 47.8 million to 60 million bags. Harvesting in the country is almost near to finish of this season. Robusta coffee crop size in Brazil is expected to be lower size on account of worst drought in recent history which may affect next year crop size as well. The production of Robusta declined near 30% to 10.75 million bags this crop against 2014/15 Robusta crop size. Brazil's Arabica crop is concentrated in South Minas, with the bulk of the country's conillon crop coming from the northern half of Espirito Santo state. Total carryover stocks from 2015/16 in June, stood between 2 million bags and 8 million bags. According to Brazil's crop supply agency Conab Brazil may grow coffee at 49.64 million bags in 2016 down slightly from its May forecast, after losses from drought in Robusta growing regions eclipsed gains in Arabica areas.

Dry weather is expected to continue for a while, and flowering is due to start. Most producers in the region talk of losses and more traders feel that production in Brazil could be less than 50 million bags. Robusta production is improving for the next crop in Vietnam with improved rains. It has been wet in Indonesia and the harvest there has been affected. Producers in Central America are expecting mixed production this year, but most seem optimistic on good production potential. They have been selling as the region gets ready for the next production that is just around the corner. Conditions seem generally good there right now.

As per USDA recent report, coffee production of the world is estimated slight higher by 1.56% at 155,697 thousands 60 kg bags for 2016/17 season against 153292 thousands 60 kg bags in 2015/16.where as, consumption of the world is placed at 150806 thousands 60 kg bags with an increase of 1.15% from last season record. However, ending stocks, exports, and imports are forecasted down by 2.59% to 129055, 0.64% to 120265 and 23% to 31499 thousands 60 kg bags respectively as compared to previous year record.

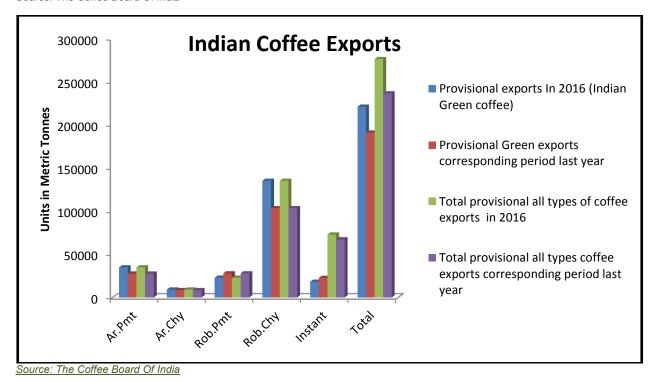

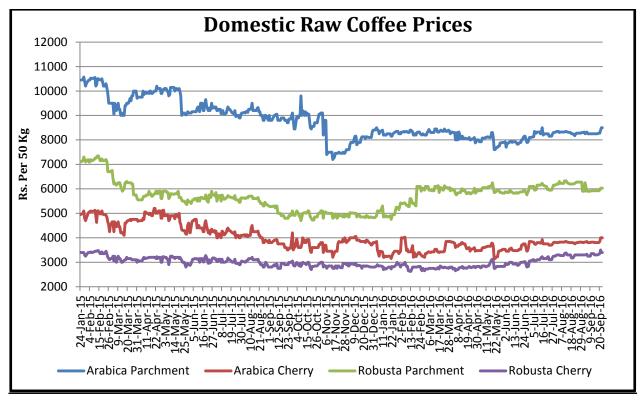

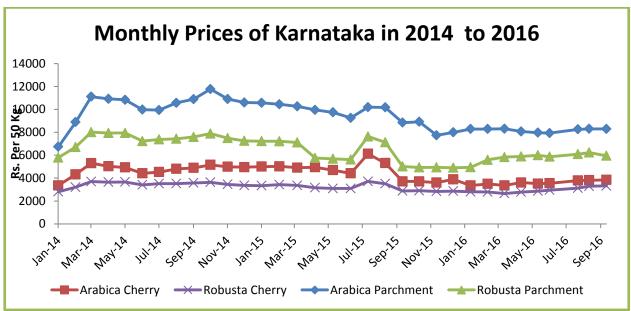

International Market Updates

ICE coffee future prices increased by 5.35% to 155.50 cents/lb in this week as on 22nd Sep 2016 against 147.60 cents/lb of the last week. As per RTRS, ICE certified stocks declined by 1458 bags to 1263187 bags as on September 22, 2016 against previous day record i.e. 1264645. As per recent ICO report, certified stocks on the London and New York future market is registered at 2.37 million bags and 1.45 million bags in August 2016 respectively. Total stocks on London exchange of July month stood lower by 3.26% while it is registered same as August month.

Brazil: As per Cacafe, Brazil shipped 2.40 million 60 kg bags of green coffee beans in August 2016 with a decline of 7.4% against 2.59 million bags in previous year during the same period of time. Arabica coffee went up by 7.5% to 2.36 million bags in August 2016 from a year ago. Robusta exports slumped by 90% to 39,327 bags from the same month last year due to the drought damage in the main Robusta grower Espirito Santo earlier this year.

Vietname:- As per the customs department, total shipment of Vietnam is recorded at 152678 tonnes (2.54 million 60 kg bags) of coffee in August 2016 with an increase in 9.2% from July 2016. Total coffee exports from October 2015 to August 2016 is higher by 33% to 1.61 million bags of the first 11 months of the 2015/16 crop year as compared to last year record during the same period of time. Traders had forecast coffee shipments of August at 100,000-120,000 tonnes, while the government estimated the volume at 140,000 tonnes.

World:- According to USDA report, coffee production of the World for 2016/17 is likely to rise by 2.4 million bags to 155.7 million bags (60 kg bags) from the previous year as record Arabica output in Brazil more than offsets lower Robusta production in Brazil, Vietnam, and Indonesia. As a result, world Arabica output is forecasted to rebound to 60 percent of total production after being below this level during the previous 5 years. While, global consumption is estimated at a record 150.8 million bags, drawing ending inventories to a 4-year low. World exports are expected to decline from last year's record primarily due to lower shipments from Indonesia, Vietnam, and Brazil.

Others:-

- **A) Guatemala:-** As per the National Coffee Association report, Guatemala exported higher coffee beans by 27.07% or 64353 bags for the month of August 2016 compared to the same month last year which stood at 302,048 bags. As a result, cumulative coffee exports to the first eleven months of the present October 2015 to September 2016 coffee year stood up by 77,916 bags or 2.84% against the same period in the previous coffee year, at a total of 2,823,267 bags.
- **B**) According to the European Coffee Federation, Coffee stocks held in European ports went up by 2.4 percent in June, as on 20th Sep 2016. Stocks at the end of June climbed to 742,142 tonnes as compared to 724,681 tonnes previous month. ECF figures cover the major coffee storage ports of Antwerp, Bremen, Hamburg, Genoa, Le Havre and Trieste.
- c) The province of Lampung shipped total 24,323 tons valued at US\$42.5 million of Robusta coffee in August, 2016 against earlier month record .The exports surged from 12,349 tons valued at US\$20.7 million in July because of an increase in the export earning which supported export volume to rise following good harvest this year. Coffee production of Lampung increased by 30 percent compared with production from previous season last year. The exports were to meet contracts with buyers abroad. Lampung's exports of coffee both Robusta and Arabica, were shipped mainly to Europe and other Asian countries. Lampung also exports Arabica coffee beans, but not as much as Robusta coffee. Arabica coffee exports totaled only 19.2 tons valued at US\$101,568 in August, 2016. The destination countries included Algeria, Armenia, Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Egypt, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, India, Italy, Japan, Malaysia, Morocco, Portugal, Russia, Singapore, Switzerland, Britain, South Africa, Rumania, Iran, the United States and Sweden. The price of Robusta coffee from farmers in West Lampung declined due to poor quality beans. "The price of Robusta coffee beans at the level of farmers fell at present from Rp 21,000 per kilogram to Rp19,000 per kilogram on poor quality. In addition, coffee production in the region was abundant after grand harvest in July resulting in price fall.

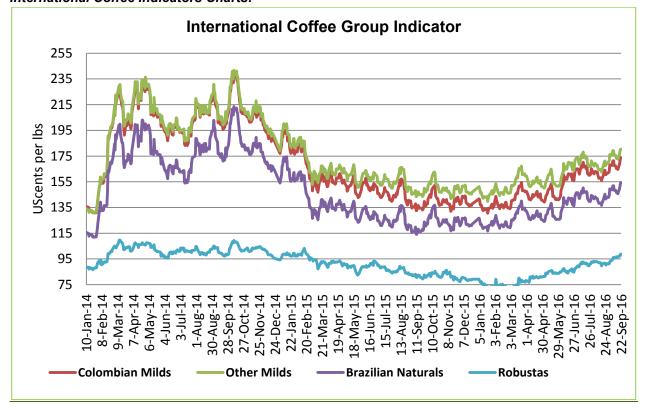

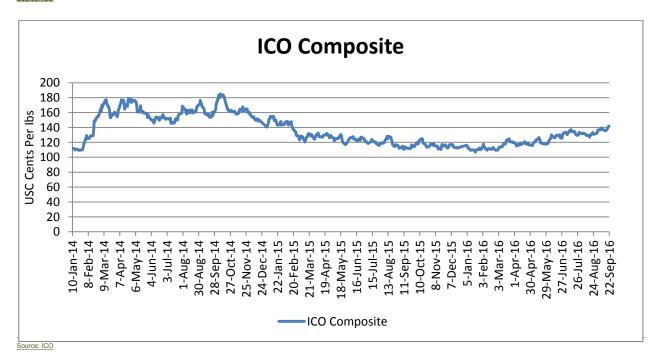
