

Executive Summary

Domestic Coffee Market Summary

Steady to strong tone were witnessed in physical market of Coffee during week ended as on 7th October 2016 on slowly improved demand of exporters & on estimation of lower crop size in the world. Arabica picking will commence from November 2016 while farmers will start picking of Robusta beans From Jan-February 2016. Farmers and traders of India expect a fall in Robusta crops production by 15 to 20% despite good monsoon. While, the coffee board of India expects 10 to 20% decline to Robusta crops of this season harvesting.

According to recent released data by the Coffee Board Of India, the post blossom estimates of total coffee crop size for the season 2016/17 is placed lower by 8.04% or (28,000 MT) to 320,000 MT against 348,000 MT in the current season 2015/16 due to poor rainfall and high temperature during growing period of time. While, Arabica coffee crop size for 2016-17 is placed down by 3.38% (3,500 MT) over the corresponding final estimate of 2015-16, while the Robusta estimate has shown a decrease of -10.02% (24,500 MT) over the corresponding final estimate of 2015-16. The hot and humid weather along with insufficient showers resulted in pinking and scorching of buds in Robusta.

As per the Coffee Board of India, provisional Indian green coffee exports to 1st January 2016 to 5th October 2016 is registered higher by 16.20 % at 229564 metric tons compared to 197556 metric tons exported to the corresponding period of previous year. India re-exports maximum Instant of coffee. Instant Coffee exports to 1st January 2016 to 5th October 2016 this year, recorded down by 19.75% at 18838 metric tons from preceding year volume of 23475 metric tons. Total provisional exports of Arabica parchment, Arabica Cherry and Robusta Cherry is placed higher by 24.99 at 35377, 7.88% to 9349 metric tonnes and 31.40% at 141579 metric tons respectively from 1st January to 5th October against exports volume of 28303 metric ton, 8666 metric tonnes and 107746 metric tons respectively in the corresponding period of last year. However, Robusta parchment is registered lower for 24188 metric tonnes with a decline 16.95%. Coffee exports volume may rise in upcoming months due to continuous rainfall in Vietnam, one of the largest producer of Robusta beans.

Recommendation:

Weekly Call -: Market participants are advised to stay away on the current level for short period.

International Coffee Market Summary

As Per the national coffee institute IHCAFE, Honduras is likely to ship total 171,334 million 60-kilogram bags of coffee in September 2016 against 41,842 60 kg bags in the same month last year. Honduras is Central America's top coffee producer, and like other regional producers is recovering from a severe outbreak of the tree-killing fungus roya over the past few seasons. It is expected that total coffee exports volume for the season 2016-17 would be well above the latest estimate of 5.12 million bags for the current 2015-16 season on account of the renovation of farms after the roya damage. Honduras had forecast exports of 5.52 million bags for the current season, but earlier in September IHCAFE lowered its expectations due to the smuggling of Honduran beans into Guatemala and Mexico. The coffee season runs from October through September.

In view of trader, total shipment of Vietnam is likely to ship between 70,000 and 100,000 or 1.17 million and 1.67 million 60 kg bags in October month 2016 which is lower than 120,000 tonnes in September 2016. Total coffee exports from October 2015 to August 2016 is higher by 33% to 1.61 million bags of the first 11 months of the 2015/16 crop year as compared to last year record during the same period of time.

As per USDA recent report, coffee production of the world is estimated slight higher by 1.56% at 155,697 thousands 60 kg bags for 2016/17 season against 153292 thousands 60 kg bags in 2015/16.where as, consumption of the world is placed at 150806 thousands 60 kg bags with an increase of 1.15% from last season record. However, ending stocks, exports, and imports are forecasted down by 2.59% to 129055, 0.64% to 120265 and 23% to 31499 thousands 60 kg bags respectively as compared to previous year record.



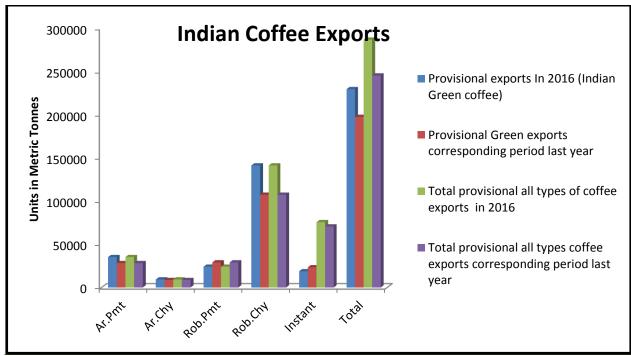

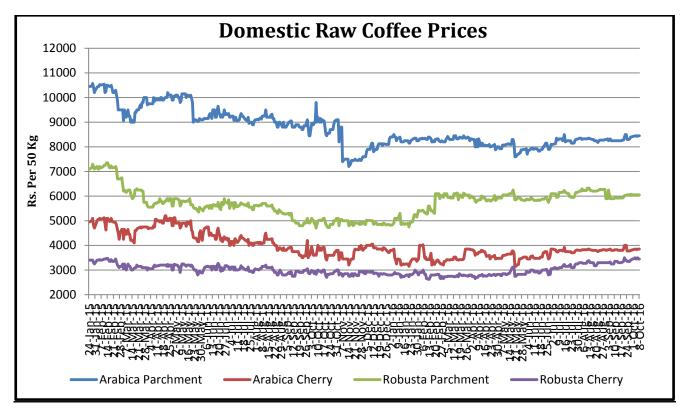

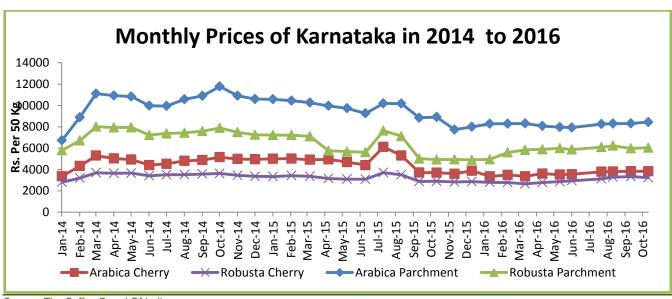




Coffee Prices Of Auction Market & State Wise Market

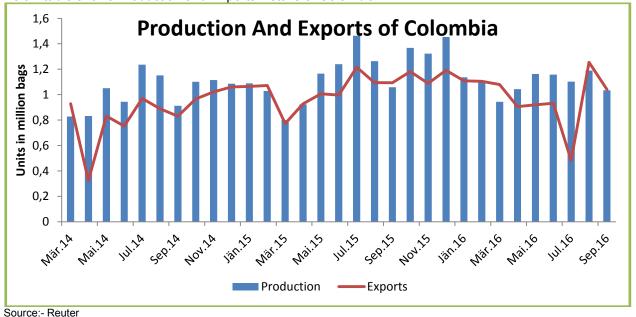


International Market Updates

ICE coffee future prices declined by 2.34% to 148 cents/lb in this week as on 6th October 2016 against 151.55 cents/lb of the last week. ICE certified Arabica stocks increased by 4,280 to 1256897 as on October 06,2016 against 1252617 bags.

Colombia:- As per sources, Washed Arabica Coffee production of Colombia stood at 1.03 million bags in September 2016 with a decline of 2% against last year record during the same period of time. Twelve-month production through September was 14 million bags, an increase of 5 percent over the previous year. Relatively total coffee export went down by 4% to 1.04 million bags as compared to last month record i.e.1.254 million bags. The figures came as coffee growers in Colombia, the world's biggest producer of mild-tasting washed Arabicas, braced for the expected La Nina weather phenomenon and potential heavy rains.

Brazil: Brazil has almost completed harvesting of this year's coffee. Arabica output was near a record, but Robusta-producing regions were severely affected by a drought for the second consecutive year. Brazil's Robusta output should fall to 8.3 million bags this year versus 11.1 million bags in 2015 and 13 million bags in 2014.

Ivory:- As per sources, Ivory coast shipped coffee beans higher by 25% to 52848 tonnes in the seven month to the end of August 2016 against 41919 tonnes of August 2015 in the corresponding period of time.

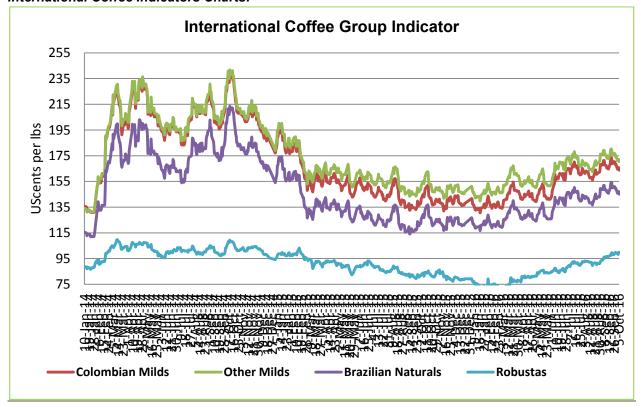

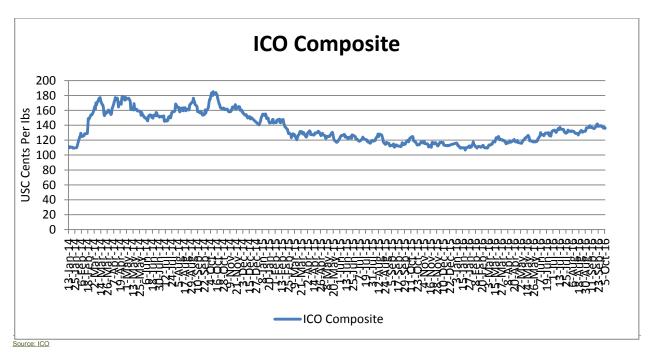
