

#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

**Market Outlook**: Cotton spot market noticed steady to firm tone on Monday.

**In The News:** The monsoon in country is likely to arrive late as forecasted by Indian Meteorological Department (IMD). IMD believes that southwest monsoon will arrive by June 5, on the southern coast of Kerala against the normal start date of June 01. IMD earlier forecasted the onset date of Monsoon as May 30 with the model error of plus-minus 4 days. Monsoon rains during the previous year i.e. 2014, arrived on Kerala coast on June 6.

Cottonseed sale could drop this Kharif season, as reported the industry. Around 4.40-4.50 crore packets (450 gm each) of cotton seed are likely to be sold in the country this season, lower when compared to the 4.75 crore packets sold last year. Currently the industry is holding the stock of 6.5 crore packets, out of which 1.5 crore packets are considered not-so-good quality seeds.

Around 8.82 lakh hectares of cotton have been planted as on 29<sup>th</sup> May throughout the country, approximately 14.25% higher when compared the sowing of cotton during the corresponding period last year which was 7.72 lakh hectares, said Press Information Bureau (PIB).

India exported 0.622 lakh bales of cotton last week (18-24 May 2015), which was 0.416 lakh bales previous to last week (11-17 May 2015), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch. Imports on the other hand stood 0.128 lakh bales last week, which was 0.383 lakh bales previous to last week.

The loss of around Rs 2,500 crore is likely to incur by government on cotton procurement scheme, which was aimed to save the farmers from the crashing cotton prices held in the current marketing year through September, said Textile minister Santosh Kumar Gangwar. The losses were earlier estimated to be around Rs 4000 crore, said Gangwar. The loss could still be lower than Rs 2500 crore if cotton price improves.

Around eight textile industry association in Tamil Nadu urged the state minister (road transport, national highways and shipping) to relax Cabotage law in order to make transport of cotton from Gujarat to Tamil Nadu easier. Under the law the Indian vessel will be given the first preference for the transportation of good from one port to another and any foreign vessel could get chance only when Indian vessel in not available and the India's maritime regulator issues the license to foreign vessel.

The southwest rains this season are predicted to be below normal for the second consecutive year, according to the IMD. According to the market participants, unlike the other crops, the deficit in rainfall would not impact cotton output and rather it could benefit cotton as it is the desert crop.

The Bharatiya Janata Kisan Morcha, (BJKM) the farmers' wing of the BJP in Hyderabad demanded the state government to make the sufficient quality cotton seeds available to farmers before the first spell of monsoon. The BJKM also urged government to blacklist the fake seed companies and asked for the strict action against the companies who provide spurious seed.

Maharashtra government has urged cotton seed companies to reduce the price of Bt cotton seeds by Rs 100 per bag from Rs 930 per bag of 450 gram seeds to Rs 830 to combat the rural distress caused by the drought and then unseasonal rains. The state government may convert the same into legal decision with the provision of punishment if the seed companies do not follow the rule. However the seed companies have informed the state government about their inability to reduce the price of seed following the increase in cost of production.



#### **International Fundamentals:**

Around 60% of cotton planting has been completed in USA as on May 24 this year, which was 35% last week and 47% last year on same date, according to USDA. The five year average sowing progress is 61% as on date, slightly higher than the current sowing pace.

China imported around 160,800 tonnes of cotton in April, approximately 28.3% lower when compared to the volume imported during the same month last year, according to the official custom data. During the initial four month of the year, imports to China fell by around 38.2 percent year on year to 609,000 tonnes, said China Cotton Association (CCA) citing custom data.

Around 44% of cotton planting has been completed in USA as on May 17 this year, which was 26% last week and 35% last year on same date, according to USDA. The five year average sowing progress is 46% as on date, slightly higher than the current sowing pace.

#### We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in near term.
