

#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

Market Outlook: Cotton spot market noticed mostly steady tone on Wednesday.

**In The News:** Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has started floating the global tender for cotton export to Bangladesh. The tender earlier did not attract the mush attention as the prices quoted by CCI was 76-77 cents whereas the working price of the exporters is 68-70 cents since the Rupee has appreciated to 62.15 from 62.70 against the dollar. CCI is now working on the better and revised pricing strategy to drag down the price to 70 cents for the overseas buyers.

CCI has invited bids for the export sale of 4200 F.P. bales of cotton thorough e-auction on 10 June 2015 from the international buyer. Varieties offered for the auction was Bunny Brahma (BB) and Shankar-6 (S-6) for the Ex-port Benapole.

Cotton acreage is expected to fall by around 7% this year, said Cotton association of India (CAI) following the drastic fall in the prices in the current season and expectation of better return from other crops including soybean and Pulses. It should be noted that it is steepest fall in acreage since 2002/03.

The two key cotton growing region of Punjab i.e. Bathinda and Mukhtsar are expected to switch to other crop from cotton due to lower returns and crop loss. Farmers are likely to opt paddy over fiber crop this year despite the expectation of lower rainfall. It should be noted Punjab received only 50% of the normal rainfall during the last monsoon season i.e. June-September 2014.

Farmers in Vidarbha are advised by the divisional level officer agriculture, to delay the sowing of Kharif crop including cotton and soybean, to July first week as the monsoon is likely to get delay. In general, farmers start Kharif sowing in the region by June 15. Delayed sowing in the region could save farmers from re sowing which usually occurs due to late or scanty rains.

Cotton Association of India (CAI) projected the total cotton supply in the country at 45.36 million bales and domestic consumption at 31 million bales and leaving the surplus of 14.36 million bales. According to CAI, by the end of May, domestic mills consumption was recorded at 27.4 million bales which was around 26.66 million bales last year during the same period last year.

A notification has been issued by Government of Maharashtra to seed selling companies to reduce the price of Bt cotton seed including the varieties Bt Bollguard 1 and 2 by Rs.100 each. However no change would be made to price of non-Bt Hybrid cotton seed.

According to the Southern India Mills' Association (SIMA) the cotton ending stocks by the end of season 2014-15 is likely to stand around 70 lakh bales, highest ever cotton stock since 2008-09. As cotton production in the coming season is likely to decline on domestic and global front, higher cotton carryover stocks would place India in comfortable position on the supply side.

Around 9.32 lakh hectares of cotton have been planted as on 05<sup>th</sup> June throughout the country, approximately 14.5% lower when compared the sowing of cotton during the corresponding period last year which was 10.90 lakh hectares, said Press Information Bureau (PIB).

India exported 0.624 lakh bales of cotton last week (25-30 May 2015), which was 0.622 lakh bales previous to last week (18-24 May 2015), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch. Imports on the other hand stood 0.231 lakh bales last week, which was 0.128 lakh bales previous to last week.



#### **International Fundamentals:**

Around 87% of cotton planting has been completed in USA as on June 07 this year, which was 61% last week and 81% last year on same date, according to USDA. The five year average sowing progress is 89% as on date, slightly higher than the current sowing pace.

World cotton imports are likely to increase marginally in the coming season i.e. 2015-16, said ICAC. The cotton imports on the global front would go up by the 2% to 7.7 million tons with the increase of 3% in the imports of countries outside china to 6.1 million tons.

China imported around 160,800 tonnes of cotton in April, approximately 28.3% lower when compared to the volume imported during the same month last year, according to the official custom data. During the initial four month of the year, imports to China fell by around 38.2 percent year on year to 609,000 tonnes, said China Cotton Association (CCA) citing custom data.

#### **Outlook**

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in near term.
