

**Domestic Fundamentals:**

**Market Outlook:** Cotton spot market noticed steady to weak tone on Monday.

**In The News:** Central Institute for Cotton Research (CICR) has issued the district specific advisory for sowing cotton across the country, considering the difference in the status of monsoon in different states. CICR has suggested the immediate sowing in Maharashtra in the coming week particularly in Jalgaon, yavatmal, Nanded, Amravati, Buldana and Aurangabad districts as dry situation is expected in the period of July 03-16.

India exported 0.449 lakh bales of cotton last week (08-14 June 2015), which was 0.453 lakh bales previous to last week (31 May-07 June 2015), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch. Imports on the other hand stood 0.259 lakh bales last week, which was 0.254 lakh bales previous to last week.

Minimum Support Price (MSP) of cotton has been revised upwardly for the year 2015-16 by Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CACP) by Rs 50 for each of Medium and Long staple. The MSP of Medium staple cotton has been revised to Rs 3800 per quintal for 2015-16 which was Rs. 3750 in 2014-15. Similarly, the MSP for Long staple has been revised to Rs. 4100 for the upcoming season 2015-16, which was Rs 4050 in the current season.

Cotton consumption in India is likely to increase by around 5.09% in the coming season i.e. 2015-16 to 5.606 million tones as compared to 5.334 million tones in the current season, said USDA. Consumption on global front too is likely to increase by around 3.44% to 25.10 million tones in 2015-16 as compared to 24.27 million tones in current season.

Around 14.3 lakh hectares of cotton has been sown so far throughout the country, as on 12 June this year, which is around 17.5% lower when compared to the sowing progress of last season during the corresponding period which was 17.34 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

All India cotton arrivals, as on May 30, 2015 has reached 27.5 million 480 lb. bales (35.3 million 170 kg bales/5.9 mmt), as reported by the Cotton Corporation of India (CCI). The pace of arrivals has slowed by around 5 percent when compared to last year. CCI procurement under MSP stood at 6.8 million 480 lb. bales (8.7 million 170 kg bales/1.5 mmt) during the current season. CCI sales reported as of May 30 have recorded 1 million 480 lb. bales (1.3 million 170 kg bales/221,000 mt).

Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has started floating the global tender for cotton export to Bangladesh. The tender earlier did not attract the much attention as the prices quoted by CCI was 76-77 cents whereas the working price of the exporters is 68-70 cents since the Rupee has appreciated to 62.15 from 62.70 against the dollar. CCI is now working on the better and revised pricing strategy to drag down the price to 70 cents for the overseas buyers.

CCI has invited bids for the export sale of 4200 F.P. bales of cotton thorough e-auction on 10 June 2015 from the international buyer. Varieties offered for the auction was Bunny Brahma (BB) and Shankar-6 (S-6) for the Ex-port Benapole.

Cotton acreage is expected to fall by around 7% this year, said Cotton association of India (CAI) following the drastic fall in the prices in the current season and expectation of better return from other crops including soybean and Pulses. It should be noted that it is steepest fall in acreage since 2002/03.

### International Fundamentals:

Around 91% of cotton planting has been completed in USA as on June 14 this year, which was 81% last week and 94% last year on same date, according to USDA. The five year average sowing progress is 96% as on date, slightly higher than the current sowing pace.

In the month of May, China imported 163,000 tons of cotton, around 14.8 percent lower when compared to the imports during the same month in 2014. China cotton imports has fallen drastically this year after the country announced that it would restrict low-tariff quotas to 894,000 tons, the amount agreed with World Trade Organisation.

World cotton production estimates for the season 2015-16 has been upwardly revised by USDA. Cotton production on global front is likely to stand around 24.238 million tons in the coming season around 0.07% higher when compared to the estimates of previous month which was 24.222 million tons and around 6.34% lower when compared to the production of current month.

### Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in near term.
