

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot market steady to weak tone on Thursday.

In The News: India exported 0.439 lakh bales of cotton last week (15-21 June 2015), which was 0.449 lakh bales previous to last week (08-14 June 2015), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch. Imports on the other hand stood 0.297 lakh bales last week, which was 0.259 lakh bales previous to last week.

According to Investment Information and Credit Rating Agency of India (ICRA), cotton prices in year 2016 is likely to remain range bound despite the expectation of fall in production by 10-15%. ICRA in its report said that in the last four year (CY 2011-12 to 2014-15), the global cotton prices and trade were majorly driven by government policies in various producing and consuming countries, despite the increasing supply and negligible growth in demand.

Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has sold around 15 lakh bales of cotton so far from the stock of 87 lakh bales which it procured during the current season under the procurement operation, said Indian Cotton Federation (ICF).

Cotton sowing has been started in almost every cotton growing region including Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Karnataka following the arrival of good rainfall in the states. Cumulative rainfall during 01 June to 22 June in the current monsoon season (starting form 01 June) stood 126.1 mm, around 21% higher than the normal rainfall of 103.8 mm for the same period.

Central Institute for Cotton Research (CICR) has issued the district specific advisory for sowing cotton across the country, considering the difference in the status of monsoon in different states. CICR has suggested the immediate sowing in Maharashtra in the coming week particularly in Jalgaon, yavatmal, Nanded, Amravati, Buldana and Aurangabad districts as dry situation is expected in the period of July 03-16.

Around 19.66 lakh hectares of cotton has been sown so far throughout the country, as on 19 June this year, which is around 1.7% lower when compared to the sowing progress of last season during the corresponding period which was 20.00 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

Minimum Support Price (MSP) of cotton has been revised upwardly for the year 2015-16 by Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CACP) by Rs 50 for each of Medium and Long staple. The MSP of Medium staple cotton has been revised to Rs 3800 per quintal for 2015-16 which was Rs. 3750 in 2014-15. Similarly, the MSP for Long staple has been revised to Rs. 4100 for the upcoming season 2015-16, which was Rs 4050 in the current season.

Cotton consumption in India is likely to increase by around 5.09% in the coming season i.e. 2015-16 to 5.606 million tones as compared to 5.334 million tones in the current season, said USDA. Consumption on global front too is likely to increase by around 3.44% to 25.10 million tones in 2015-16 as compared to 24.27 million tones in current season.

All India cotton arrivals, as on May 30, 2015 has reached 27.5 million 480 lb. bales (35.3 million 170 kg bales/5.9 mmt), as reported by the Cotton Corporation of India (CCI). The pace of arrivals has slowed by around 5 percent when compared to last year. CCI procurement under MSP stood at 6.8 million 480 lb. bales (8.7 million 170 kg bales/1.5 mmt) during the current season. CCI sales reported as of May 30 have recorded 1 million 480 lb. bales (1.3 million 170 kg bales/221,000 mt).

International Fundamentals:

Around 94% of cotton planting has been completed in USA as on June 21 this year, which was 91% last week and 99% last year on same date, according to USDA. The five year average sowing progress is 100% as on date, slightly higher than the current sowing pace.

In the month of May, China imported 163,000 tons of cotton, around 14.8 percent lower when compared to the imports during the same month in 2014. China cotton imports has fallen drastically this year after the country announced that it would restrict low-tariff quotas to 894,000 tons, the amount agreed with World Trade Organisation.

World cotton production estimates for the season 2015-16 has been upwardly revised by USDA. Cotton production on global front is likely to stand around 24.238 million tons in the coming season around 0.07% higher when compared to the estimates of previous month which was 24.222 million tons and around 6.34% lower when compared to the production of current month.

Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in near term.
