

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot market noticed steady to firm tone on Thursday.

In The News: Around 95.78% of the cotton sowing has been completed in Gujarat against the normal area under cotton in state, according to State Agriculture Department. Area sown for cotton as on 10 August 2015 stood 26.11 lakh hectares in Gujarat against the total normal area of 27.26 lakh hectares and previous year as on date area of 29.30 lakh hectares.

In Andhra Pradesh, around 69% of the cotton planting against the normal area under cotton in the state has been completed so far. Around 4.032 lakh hectares of cotton has been planted as on 12 August 2015 which is around 26.4% lower when compared to the area sown for cotton during the same period last year.

India's cotton production estimates for season 2015-16 by USDA have been revised downwardly at million tons 6.314 (371.4 Lakh bales, of 170 kg each), around 4.5% lower when compared to the estimates of previous month i.e. 6.423 million tons (377.8 Lakh bales, of 170 kg each).

In order to formulate a policy to give farmers the remunerative cotton prices, textile ministry will hold a meeting next month with the ministries of commerce, labour and agriculture. The decision of holding this meeting came after the Minister of Labour, along with 26 delegates member met the Minister of Textiles Santosh Gangwar in New Delhi to discuss the situation of cotton farmers, especially in Telangana.

Around 105.68 lakh hectares of cotton has been sown so far throughout the country, as on 07 August this year. This is around 5.84% lower than the corresponding sowing progress of last season which was 112.24 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

According to International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC), India is likely to produce 6.4 million tones of cotton in 2015-16, 2% lower as compared to the previous year. Cotton stock in the country by the end of current season (Oct'14-Sept'15) is likely to be around 2.2 million tones. By the end of July, CCI has sold around 650,000 tonnes of cotton from the total procured amount of 1.5mt. ICAC believes that the cotton export during the season 2014-15 would stand 51% lower year on year basis at 980,000 tonnes.

Cotton Association of India (CAI) kept its cotton production estimates for season 2014-15 at 382.75 lakh bales in June, unchanged from the previous month estimates. According to the association, total cotton supply would be around 453.65 lakh bales and the consumption would stand around 315 lakh bales. Total available surplus including exports would be around 138.56 lakh bales.

The inability of Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) to sell the cotton, which it procured under MSP operation is likely to lead to the bulged cotton stock in the country. According to Cotton Association of India (CAI) cotton inventory are likely to increase by around 25% to 7.39 million bales in 2014-15 as compared to 5.89 million bales a year ago. Following the situation cotton prices are likely to go southwards further.

Cotton export to China from India has declined by 56.72 per cent in 2014-15, which has caused cotton prices in domestic market to fall drastically. In year 2014-15 India exported only 26 lakh bales of cotton to China in 2014-15 against 61 lakh bales in 2013-14. Citing the situation, Commerce and Industry Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said in the written reply to Rajya Sabha that due to this reason cotton domestic prices are ruling weaker as compared to the previous year and cotton policy adopted by China is the major cause for less imports.

World cotton production in 2015-16 is likely to stand lowest in last five years, said USDA. Cotton output on global front is likely to be around 23.73 million tons, as per the latest estimates by USDA, around 2.2% lower as compared to the estimates of previous month for the current season, and around 8.3% lower when compared to production of previous season of 25.906 million tons.

World cotton export according to the latest USDA estimates would be around 7.51 million tons in 2015-16, around 1.37% higher when compared to the estimates of previous month for the same season and around 2.8% lower when compared to actual export of previous season which was 7.73 million tons.

USDA in its August estimates has revised the world cotton imports estimates for season 2015-16 upwardly at 7.52 million tons as compared to the July estimates of 7.413 million tons, due to the expectation of higher consumption anticipated in current season i.e. 2015-16. However the imports would still be lower by 4.3% when compared to the previous season imports of 7.865 million tons.

Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in the near -term.
