



Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot market noticed mostly steady tone on Wednesday.

In The News: Cotton Association of India (CAI) has released its first estimates for season 2015-16. According to CAI cotton production in the country would be around 380 lakh bales, and would be majorly contributed by the central zone of the country including the states Gujarat, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh. On the better arrival of rain, which has boosted the yield, cotton production would stand similar to the current season in 2015-16, despite the fall in acreage. Total supply would be around 470.65 lakh bales where as domestic consumption would be around 325 lakh bales.

Farmers in Bathinda and Mansa districts of Punjab have starting uprooting the cotton crop as whitefly attack has damaged the crop in the region, despite the heavy use of pesticide. According to the growers, it is better to uproot the crop than to bear the expense which would have gone more than double of MSP of crop which is Rs 3950 per quintal.

Around 110.23 lakh hectares of cotton has been sown so far throughout the country, as on 21 August this year. This is around 7.22% lower than the corresponding sowing progress of last season which was 118.81 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

Despite the weak cotton price prevailing in the market, prices of cotton seeds have increased by around 30% in last four year to Rs 23 per kg from Rs 17 per Kg. Demand of de-oiled cotton cake (DOC) and cotton seed oil, which is used as edible oil and illegal mixing with expensive edible oil, has dragged the cotton seed price upward in the market.

Department of Agriculture, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its fourth advance estimates, has revised the cotton production estimates upwardly for the season 2014-15 at 354.75 lakh bales (of 170 kg each), which was earlier estimated to be around 353.28 lakh bales in third advance estimates. Production target for the season 2014-15 has been set at 350 lakh bales. Cotton production according to final estimates of DAC for the season 2013-14 was 359.02 lakh bales.

Around 98.26% of the cotton sowing has been completed in Gujarat against the normal area under cotton in state, according to State Agriculture Department. Area sown for cotton as on 17 August 2015 stood 26.79 lakh hectares in Gujarat against the total normal area of 27.26 lakh hectares and previous year as on date area of 29.53 lakh hectares.

In Andhra Pradesh, around 76.8% of the cotton planting against the normal area under cotton in the state has been completed so far. Around 4.49 lakh hectares of cotton has been planted as on 19 August 2015 which is around 23.3% lower when compared to the area sown for cotton during the same period last year.

Due to dull demand and high input costs, cotton spinning mills could cut down the production in the coming year. Representatives of the textile bodies including Confederation of Indian Textile Industry, South India Millers' Association, North Indian Millers Association, and Texprocil met in capital to decide to appoint and agency to analyze the depth of current situation and prepare a memorandum to be sent to government.

Cotton exports from India could go up in 2015-16 to 1.18 million tons (69.41 Lakh Bales), around 20.4% higher when compared to 0.98 million tons (57.64 Lakh Bales) in the current season ending in September this year, said International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC).

International Fundamentals:

According to China Cotton Association (CCA), the country is likely to produce 5.5 million tones of cotton in year 2015-16, slightly lesser than the previous estimates of 5.86 million tons. The production however is likely to stand fairly lower when compared to the production of 6.5 million tons in year 2014-15.

World cotton production in 2015-16 is likely to stand lowest in last five years, said USDA. Cotton output on global front is likely to be around 23.73 million tons, as per the latest estimates by USDA, around 2.2% lower as compared to the estimates of previous month for the current season, and around 8.3% lower when compared to production of previous season of 25.906 million tons.

World cotton export according to the latest USDA estimates would be around 7.51 million tons in 2015-16, around 1.37% higher when compared to the estimates of previous month for the same season and around 2.8% lower when compared to actual export of previous season which was 7.73 million tons.

Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in the near -term.
