

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot market noticed mixed tone on Monday.

In The News: Around 114.75 lakh hectares of cotton has been sown so far throughout the country, as on 11 September this year. This is around 8.5% lower than the corresponding sowing progress of last season which was 125.29 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

According to the latest estimates by ICAC (International cotton advisory committee), cotton production in India is likely to be around 6.37 million ton (375 lakh bales of 170 kg each) in 2015-16, around 2.15% lower when compared to the estimates production of 6.51 million tons (383 lakh bales) in 2014-15.

According to USDA's FAS (Foreign Agriculture Services), Mumbai, Cotton production in India would be around 37 million bales (of 170 kg each) in the season 2015-16 starting from October. Yield is expected to stand around 524 Kg per hectares against the five year average yield of 527 kg per hectare. The reason for the fall in the yield is the deficient rainfall in the latter half of the monsoon season which has slowed down the boll development and attack of pink bollworm and whitefly on the crop in Gujarat and Punjab respectively.

Around 377.5 lakh bales of cotton has been arrived in the market till 27 August 2015 from the 2014-15 crop, is the 97 percent of the total production during the season, said Cotton Corporation of India (CCI). CCI has auctioned 54.5 lakh bales (of 170 kg each), which is around 62 percent of the total procurement done by the CCI under the Minimum Support Price (MSP) operation during the season 2014-15.

Gujarat is likely to produce 95.29 Lakh tons of cotton in 2015-16 according to the first advance estimate released by the State Agriculture Department. Yield of cotton (lint yield) would stand around 600 kg per hectares in 2015-16.

Cotton Association of India (CAI) has released its first estimates for season 2015-16. According to CAI cotton production in the country would be around 380 lakh bales, and would be majorly contributed by the central zone of the country including the states Gujarat, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh. On the better situation of rain, which has boosted the yield, cotton production would stand similar to the current season in 2015-16, despite the fall in acreage. Total supply would be around 470.65 lakh bales where as domestic consumption would be around 325 lakh bales.

Cotton output in central region of the India, including Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra is likely to be around 203 lakh bales in 2015-16, marginally lower than the current season's output of 204.50 lakh bales, said CAI. In northern zone, which includes Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan cotton output is expected to surge slightly to 55.50 in 2015 from 53.50 lakh bales in current season. In southern region, including Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu cotton production is expected to fall slightly to 115.50 lakh bales in 2015-16 from 118.75 lakh bales in current season.

Department of Agriculture, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its fourth advance estimates, has revised the cotton production estimates upwardly for the season 2014-15 at 354.75 lakh bales (of 170 kg each), which was earlier estimated to be around 353.28 lakh bales in third advance estimates. Production target for the season 2014-15 has been set at 350 lakh bales. Cotton production according to final estimates of DAC for the season 2013-14 was 359.02 lakh bales.



International Fundamentals:

USDA has further slashed down the cotton production estimates for the season 2015-16 to 23.67 million tons in September, which was earlier estimated to be around 23.73 million tons a month ago. Cotton production for the season 2014-15, according to USDA would be standing around 25.89 million tons.

World cotton exports in 2015-16 according to USDA are likely to be around 7.45 million tons as per the latest estimates by USDA, slightly lower than 7.51 million tons, which was estimated a month ago. According to USDA, world cotton export for the season 2014-15 is likely to stand around 7.70 million tons.

USDA has revised the world cotton consumption estimates for 2015-16 downwardly to 24.69 million tons, which was estimated to be around 24.96 million tons in August estimates. The downwards revision in the consumption figures is the result of fall in the consumption estimates of major consumers including India, Pakistan and Turkey majorly. No Change by consumption of China and Bangladesh is made by USDA this month. It should be noted that the consumption for the season 2014-15 would be standing around 24.28 million tons.

Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in the near -term.
