

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot market noticed mostly firm tone on Friday.

In The News: Cotton consumption in India is likely to be around 5.6 million ton (approx. 330 lakh bales) in 2015-16, according to International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC), around 3.13% higher when compared to the previous year's consumption of 5.43 million tons (approx. 320 lakh bales).

According to India Ratings & Research (Ind-Ra), the duty free trade agreement between 12 nation i.e. Trans-Pacific-Partnership (TPP) could affect the Indian textile exports negatively as these twelve member nations make the 40 percent of the world trade and the partnership gives them the free access to each other countries and making imports from other countries unviable.

According to the industry officials, the Government has to buy more cotton this year from farmers under MSP operation as compared to the previous year as China, the leading importer of cotton has cut down it cotton import drastically. During the previous season too, government procure the record volume of around 87 lakh bales valuing rupee 160 billion as compared to the 4 lakh bales previous to previous year. The swelling stocks of cotton which is making the availability to lead would affect the prices negatively in domestic market.

The SIMA (Southern India Mills' Association) has blamed CCI (Cotton Corporation of India) for quoting the higher cotton price as compared to the actual market prices. SIMA also said that the CCI does not releases the cotton stocks on time which make the textile bodies deprived of quality cotton.

Mahyco Monsanto Biotech (India) Pvt. Ltd (MMB) has moved to court against the eight seed companies who are unable to pay \$65 million as due royalties for using its technical knowhow in producing the Bt Cotton seed, a variety which is resistant to bollworms. Seed companies, being unable to pay the royalties, are blaming government which had imposed price control on BT cotton seed by cutting 11% of the prices in Maharashtra.

According to Cotton Corporation of India (CCI), although the cotton crop in Punjab has been hit badly by whitefly attack, the prices of cotton in the state are ruling well above the MSP. CCI said that it will only intervene in the matter if the prices fall below the MSP. However CCI is gearing up for the operation and likely to open around 20 centers in the state.

India has a great export potential in Vietnam for cotton, said the Vice Chairman, Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry (VCCI) during Vietnam-India co-operation conference held in Ha Noi recently. He said the country need more than 500000 tons of cotton per year, and only 1 per cent of producers' demand is fulfilled by the country's output. India, on the other hand is the world major producer of cotton and second largest manufacturer of the fibers, which opens the doors of India to Vietnam for trade.

Due to the white fly attack, cotton crop in Punjab and Haryana is likely to fall by around 40% collectively this season, according to the market participants. Cotton output in Punjab would stand around 7 Lakh bales in the current season, against the output of 14 Lakh bales in previous season. Similarly in Haryana cotton production would be around 15 lakh bales in the current season as compared to the 25 Lakh Bales in previous season.



International Fundamentals:

According to latest release of International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC), cotton imports to China is likely to be around 1.59 million tons in 2015-16, around 11.6% lower as compared to the imports of 1.8 million tons during 2014-15.

China Cotton Index (3128B) remained 93.3 cents per pound as on 20 October 2015, said ICAC, around 0.60 cents lower when compared to the previous week. Last year the same was 109.1 cents and 145.4 cents two years ago. The season high of CCI is 96.3 cents and season low is 92.7 cents per pound so far.

According to the customs data reported by industry website, China imported 50,900 tons of cotton in September, around 58.6 percent lower as compared to previous year's import during the same period and lowest monthly import volume since at least 2005.
