

#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

Market Outlook: Cotton spot market noticed mixed tone on Monday.

**In The News**: The Director General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) issued notice for inclusion of export of cotton fabrics (woven and knitted) and cotton made-ups to leading markets, including African countries under the Merchandise Exports from India Scheme (MEIS). The step taken by government is likely to escalate export as the scheme consist the export benefit of two percent.

Cotton output in India is likely to be around 370.50 lakh bales in the current season that is 2015-16, according to cotton association of India (CAI). As per the latest estimates of CAI, total cotton supply on the domestic front would be around 463.15 and consumption would stand around 325 lakh bales, with the left over surplus of 138.15 lakh bales. For the previous season, CAI had estimated the production of 382.75 lakh bales.

According to Cotton Association of India (CAI), due to the attack of white fly, cotton production in Punjab and Haryana is likely to drop by around 23 percent and 20 percent respectively. Cotton production on Punjab would stand around 10 lakh bales this year as compared to 13 lakh bales during previous year. However in Haryana, cotton output in the current season would be around 19 lakh bales as compared to 23.5 lakh bales. Although Punjab and Haryana are expected to bear the loss in cotton production due to whitefly attack, the maximum fall in the production would be noticed in Karnataka. According to CAI, cotton production in Karnataka is expected to decrease by around 35% to 20 lakh bales due to drought in the state.

Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) is currently holding 12 Lakh bales of cotton produced during the previous season. CCI procured around 87 lakh bales of cotton during the season 2014-15 under the MSP operation. According to the market participant CCI could receive good demand after the festival season as the produce it is holding is moisture free fiber, for which the spinner and textile mills could bid well.

According to the market participant, the steady pace is recorded cotton arrivals due to the commencement of festival season but the same is expected to surge up remarkably after Diwali. All India daily average arrival is hovering around 50 thousand bales.

Junagadh Agriculture University (JAU) has predicted raw cotton prices to remain firm during November to January period in the current season due to the scarcity of quality crop and anticipation of growth in export demand. JAU Believes that the cotton price during the period would be around Rs 840-920 per 20 kg in spot market, which are currently hovering in the range of Rs 825-880.

In Haryana, cotton ginners have gone on indefinite strike and not buying cotton from mandis due to the gap in the tax refund. According to the president of the Haryana Cotton Ginners Association, only 2.2 per cent is being refunded to the ginner from the 4.2 percent of value added tax pain on raw cotton, forfeiting the payment of two percent. As the ginners are not buying cotton, the price of the commodity could go down remarkably in the state.

Cotton consumption in India is likely to be around 5.6 million ton (approx. 330 lakh bales) in 2015-16, according to International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC), around 3.13% higher when compared to the previous year's consumption of 5.43 million tons (approx. 320 lakh bales).



## **International Fundamentals:**

The recent rise in the cotton prices in Pakistan has improved the import parity. Spinners have booked the import order from India and other exporting nations. So far around 1.4 million bales of cotton has been booked to be imported to country and the volume is likely to go around 2.5 million bales.

According to latest release of International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC), cotton imports to China is likely to be around 1.59 million tons in 2015-16, around 11.6% lower as compared to the imports of 1.8 million tons during 2014-15.

China Cotton Index (3128B) remained 93.3 cents per pound as on 20 October 2015, said ICAC, around 0.60 cents lower when compared to the previous week. Last year the same was 109.1 cents and 145.4 cents two years ago. The season high of CCI is 96.3 cents and season low is 92.7 cents per pound so far.

### **Outlook**

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in the near -term.
