

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot prices noticed mostly weak tone on Friday.

In The News: Mahyco Monsanto, a joint venture of US agriculture company Monsanto and Indian counterpart Maharashtra Hybrid seeds Company (Mahyco) has moved to Delhi High Court once again, requesting a stay on the functioning of the a nine member committee formed to set the maximum selling price (MSP)of cotton seed.

Cotton exports from India are likely to stand around 21.27% higher at 70 lakh bales this season that is 2015-16 as compared to 57.72 lakh bales previous season, according to the Textile Commissioner. The rise in exports is basically due to the drastic rise in cotton imports by Pakistan following the crop damage in the Punjab region of the country. Around 16.60 lakh bales of cotton has been imported by Pakistan so far in the current season as compared to the 3.79 lakh bales in the entire season of 2014-15.

India is likely to produce 35.2 million bales of cotton in season 2015-16, 3.6 percent lower as compared to previous estimates, according to a senior government official. Last year the country produced around 38 million bales of cotton.

According to the second advance estimates released by the State agriculture department of Rajasthan, cotton production in the state is likely to be around 9.55 lakh bales around 38% lower as compared to the previous estimates of 15.36 lakh bales which were forecasted in September. Last season the state produced around 15.27 lakh bales of cotton, said the department.

The government should not consider any proposal to relax duty and tax on the import of cotton from India, said the Pakistan Cotton Ginner Association (PGCA) as the same could hurt the domestic market by dumping of cheap raw material. It should be noted that government of Pakistan had imposed 10 per cent duty on imports of cotton yarn, grey and processed fabric specially coming from India which was effective from November 01, 2015.

A nine member committee has been constituted by central government to execute the cotton price control order that will set the prices famers pay to seed companies to get cotton seeds. However the seed companies including Mahyco Monsanto are not happy with the decision of setting Maximum Sale Price (MSP) by government.

India exported 0.85 lakh bales of cotton last week (18 Jan-24 Jan 2016), which was 1.8 lakh bales previous to last week (11 Jan-17 Jan 2016), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch. Imports on the other hand stood 0.10 lakh bales last week, which was 0.93 lakh bales previous to last week.

Major importer of Indian cotton during the week was Bangladesh. According to the data released by IBIS, Bangladesh imported 0.27 lakh bales of cotton in the past week (i.e. 18 Jan-24 Jan 2016). Other major importers were Pakistan, China, Vietnam and Indonesia and their imported volumes were 0.26 lakh bales, 0.11 lakh bales, 0.07 lakh bales and 0.05 lakh bales respectively. India imported cotton mainly from Australia, USA Tanzania followed by Turkmenistan and Togo. The respective volumes these countries exported to India during the week are 0.067 lakh bales, 0.020 lakh bales, 0.009 lakh bales, 0.007 lakh bales, 0.001 Lakh Bales.



International Fundamentals:

According to the latest estimates by International cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC), cotton production on the global front during the season 2016-17 would be around 23.08 million tons, around 2.8% higher when compared to the estimates of 22.46 million tons in the current season.

According to the latest ICAC weekly report, cotton exports on the global front are likely to be around 7.42 million tons in season 2015-16, around 0.3% lower when compared to the estimates of 7.44 million tons previous week and around 3.6% lower when compared to the exports of 7.70 million tons during the previous season.

China cotton imports have moved 9 years low, according the calculation of Reuters. the country imported 188,200 tonnes of cotton in December, around 28.85 per cent lower as compared to the volume in the same month previous year. However till December the total volume for the calendar year stood 1.48 million tons, the lowest level in last nine years, according to Reuters.

Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in the near -term.



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
