

### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

Market Outlook: Cotton spot prices noticed steady to firm tone on Tuesday.

**In The News**: The Centre has withdrawn notification on Bt Cotton guidelines issued few days before. It has put the notification in public domain and has invited comments and suggestions from the stakeholders in the industry.

Cotton farmers in Raichur, Karnataka have suffered a loss of Rs.278.72 crore due to failure of Bt Cotton. Bt Cotton was sown in 1.5 lakh acres and the crop has failed in 80% of the area in the previous season.

India has tightened rules for the sale of genetically-modified seeds in the country according to government sources. It will cap royalties for any new variety that U.S. based Monsanto decides to develop and sell in the market.

In Punjab, cotton sowing till date has been done in 2.08 lakh hectares as against the target of 5 lakh hectares. In Haryana, sowing is 65 per cent of the total targeted area of 6.20 lakh hectares. According to officials, farmers have shifted to other crops like paddy and pulses following crop loss last year to white fly attack and non-availability of canal water. According to farmers, acreage under cotton in Punjab is likely to reach 3.30 lakh hectares and in Haryana, it is likely to touch 5.50 lakh hectares.

According to Cotton Association of India (CAI), output of cotton in India for 2015 -16 season is estimated to be around 341 lakh bales compared to 382.75 lakh bales in 2014 -15. The projected balance sheet drawn by the CAI estimated total cotton supply for the season 2015-16 at 428.60 lakh bales while the domestic consumption is estimated at 305 lakh bales.

India exported 0.718 lakh bales of cotton last week (09 -15 May 2016), which was 0.561 lakh bales previous to last week (02 -08 May 2016), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch.

Major importer of Indian cotton during the week (09 -15 May, 2016) was Bangladesh. According to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch, Bangladesh imported 0.370 lakh bales of cotton from India in the past week (09 -15, May 2016). Other major importers were Pakistan, China, Vietnam and Indonesia and their imported volumes were 0.115 lakh bales, 0.084 lakh bales, 0.041 lakh bales and 0.003 lakh bales respectively.

Department of Agriculture, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its second advance estimates, has revised the cotton production estimates downwardly for the season 2015-16 at 306.92 lakh bales (of 170 kg each). For the season 2014-15, the estimate was 346.23 lakh bales according to the first advance estimates for the season.

The Foreign Agriculture Services (FAS), division of USDA has lowered the production forecast for India in its latest report to 356 lakh bales. The reason for the downfall in the revision is lower yield expectation in Punjab and Haryana due to the attack of white fly and impact of pink bollworm in Gujarat.

According to Cotton Association of India (CAI), the arrivals during 2015-16 season up to the end of March 2016 are estimated at 280.15 lakh bales compared to 318.45 lakh bales arrived up to the same period last year. This reduction in the arrivals of cotton is an indication of a lower crop this season.



### **International Fundamentals:**

The Chinese government has started the auction of its huge reserves of cotton this month. Stocks of cotton are expected to decline amid decline in Chinese imports and falling domestic production. The US Department of Agriculture has forecast China's cotton stocks to fall by 6% in 2015-16, to 13.9m tons. As expected, prices have started declining recently with the unloading of stocks.

Cotton output in Benin has declined to 260,000 tonnes during the 2015-16 season compared to 394,000 tonnes in the previous season.

Cotton gins are declining as Arkansas farmers abandon cotton for more profitable crops. The number of gins in the state has declined from 86 to 26 in the past 15 years according to the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette.

According to USDA latest report, global 2015/16 cotton ending stocks are revised down this month. World 2015-16 cotton production is projected at 99.8 million bales, 16 per cent below last season. World ending stocks are now projected at 102.84 million bales. For India, production is forecast at 26.8 million bales, same as previous month's estimates and India's crop is estimated 9 per cent below 2014/15 and the lowest since 2009/10.

#### **Outlook**

#### We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to firm in the near -term.
