

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot prices noticed mostly firm tone on Tuesday.

In The News: Cotton sowing has slowed down in Gujarat amid delayed monsoon. According to the State Agriculture Department, cotton sowing has reached 274,300 hectares as on June 20, 2016 compared to 1.34 million hectares during the same period previous year.

According to preliminary report by the government, cotton sowing as on 24th June, 2016 has been covered under 19.07 lakh hectares compared to 34.87 lakh hectares during the same period previous year.

Cotton acreage has declined in north Indian states in the current season 2016-17 especially in Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh. Sowing is almost complete in these states according to sources. In Haryana, cotton acreage has declined 14 per cent to 5 lakh hectares in 2016-17 crop year compared to 5.8 lakh hectares previous year and in Punjab, area planted under cotton is lower by 43.11 per cent at 2.56 lakh hectares this year compared to 4.5 lakh hectare in 2015-16. In Uttar Pradesh, area under cotton cultivation has declined 19 per cent to 0.17 lakh hectares compared to 0.21 hectares in the corresponding period of previous year.

The Cotton Association of India (CAI) has estimated India's cotton output in 2015 -16 at 341.50 lakh bales (of 170 kg each), around 10.8 per cent lower Thicompared to the previous year's production of 383 lakh bales. The projected balance sheet drawn by the CAI for 2015-16 pegs total supply at 429.10 lakh bales, while domestic consumption is seen at 305 lakh bales, thus leaving an available surplus of 124.10 lakh bales.

India exported 0.379 lakh bales of cotton last week (13 -19 June 2016), which was 0.526 lakh bales previous to last week (06 -12 June 2016), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch.

Major importer of Indian cotton during the week (13 -19 June, 2016) was Bangladesh. According to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch, Bangladesh imported 0.257 lakh bales of cotton from India in the past week (13 -19 June, 2016). Other major importers were Vietnam, China, Indonesia and Pakistan and their imported volumes were 0.052 lakh bales, 0.031 lakh bales, 0.013 lakh bales and 0.013 lakh bales respectively.

Department of Agriculture, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its second advance estimates, has revised the cotton production estimates downwardly for the season 2015-16 at 306.92 lakh bales (of 170 kg each). For the season 2014-15, the estimate was 346.23 lakh bales according to the first advance estimates for the season.

The Foreign Agriculture Services (FAS), division of USDA has lowered the production forecast for India in its latest report to 356 lakh bales. The reason for the downfall in the revision is lower yield expectation in Punjab and Haryana due to the attack of white fly and impact of pink bollworm in Gujarat.

According to Cotton Association of India (CAI), the arrivals during 2015-16 season up to the end of April 2016 are estimated at 302.40 lakh bales, lower compared to previous year. This reduction in the arrivals of cotton is an indication of a lower crop this season.



International Fundamentals:

The recent auction of cotton reserves by China is likely to support its domestic mill demand and likely to affect India's spun yarn production. According to the latest report by ICRA, the offtake by Chinese mills under ongoing reserve cotton auctions in China has put India's cotton and cotton yarn exports in a cautious mode. As per the report, India's spun yarn production grew at the slowest pace of about 3.2 per cent in the last four years. This slow pace of growth in spun yarn production has been driven by factors like lower domestic consumption and limited growth in exports.

According to a recent attaché report by USDA, seed cotton production in Zimbabwe is expected to recover to around 210,000 MT in the 2016/17 marketing year, after only 80,000 MT was produced in 2015/16 marketing year, due to extreme drought conditions. The recovery is following government's free inputs support program that will reduce the production cost to the farmers.

According to USDA latest report, global 2015/16 cotton ending stocks are revised down this month. World 2015-16 cotton production is projected at 98.15 million bales, 16 per cent below last season. World ending stocks are now projected at 102.08 million bales. For India, production is forecast at 26.8 million bales, same as previous month's estimates and India's crop is estimated 9 per cent below 2014/15 and the lowest since 2009/10.

Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to firm in the near -term.
