

#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

Market Outlook: Cotton spot prices noticed steady to firm tone on Tuesday.

**In The News**: In the current crop year, the acreage under desi cotton has increased in North India. In the previous year, crop was affected by whitefly in Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan. The acreage under desi cotton is at a decade high. Desi cotton has been planted in about 72,280 hectares this season compared to 2000 hectares in the previous year. Desi cotton accounts for less than 2 per cent of the total cotton acreage in India.

According to preliminary report by the government, cotton sowing as on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2016 has been covered under 30.59 lakh hectares compared to 60.16 lakh hectares during the same period previous year.

According to the official figures, cotton has been sown on 6.1 million acres of land in the current season across the country compared to 6.8 million acres during the same period of last year. About 80 percent of the target has been achieved, but it is 11 percent less than previous year. The government has downward revised cotton production target as well as area and fixed at 14.1 million bales from 7.4 million acres for the season 2016-17 against 15.49 million bales from 7.7 million acres estimated for the just concluded season 2015-16.

The Cotton Association of India (CAI) has estimated India's cotton output in 2015 -16 at 341.50 lakh bales (of 170 kg each), around 10.8 per cent lower compared to the previous year's production of 383 lakh bales. The projected balance sheet drawn by the CAI for 2015-16 pegs total supply at 429.10 lakh bales, while domestic consumption is seen at 305 lakh bales, thus leaving an available surplus of 124.10 lakh bales.

India exported 0.237 lakh bales of cotton last week (20 -26 June 2016), which was 0.379 lakh bales previous to last week (13 -19 June 2016), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch.

Major importer of Indian cotton during the week (20 -26 June, 2016) was Bangladesh. According to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch, Bangladesh imported 0.166 lakh bales of cotton from India in the past week (20 -26 June, 2016). Other major importers were Vietnam, Pakistan, China and Taiwan and their imported volumes were 0.036 lakh bales, 0.012 lakh bales, 0.011 lakh bales and 0.007 lakh bales respectively.

Department of Agriculture, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its second advance estimates, has revised the cotton production estimates downwardly for the season 2015-16 at 306.92 lakh bales (of 170 kg each). For the season 2014-15, the estimate was 346.23 lakh bales according to the first advance estimates for the season.

The Foreign Agriculture Services (FAS), division of USDA has lowered the production forecast for India in its latest report to 356 lakh bales. The reason for the downfall in the revision is lower yield expectation in Punjab and Haryana due to the attack of white fly and impact of pink bollworm in Gujarat.

According to Cotton Association of India (CAI), the arrivals during 2015-16 season up to the end of April 2016 are estimated at 302.40 lakh bales, lower compared to previous year. This reduction in the arrivals of cotton is an indication of a lower crop this season.



#### **International Fundamentals:**

According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC), global area under cotton is expected to contract by one per cent to 31 million hectares in 2016-17, the area in India is expected to expand by one per cent to 12 million hectares in 2016-17. Globally, the average yield is projected to improve by five per cent to 735 kg per hectare, which would cause production to increase by five per cent to 23 million tons. In India, cotton production is expected to increase by eight per cent to 6.3 million tons and better monsoons may boost yield by six per cent to 521 kg per hectare, though pest pressure remains a concern

According to Karachi Cotton Association (KCA), lower output of cotton is expected in the 2016 -17 season compared to previous season. Due to lower production in the previous season and in the coming season, the local textile industry has to import raw cotton and ensure its contribution towards achieving the target of export fixed through exports of value added products as well as earning foreign exchange for the country.

According to USDA latest report, global 2015/16 cotton ending stocks are revised down this month. World 2015-16 cotton production is projected at 98.15 million bales, 16 per cent below last season. World ending stocks are now projected at 102.08 million bales. For India, production is forecast at 26.8 million bales, same as previous month's estimates and India's crop is estimated 9 per cent below 2014/15 and the lowest since 2009/10.
