

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot prices noticed mostly firm tone on Saturday.

In The News: In the current season, cotton acreage is likely to decline by 35% as farmers are shifting to other crops like paddy, sugarcane and pulses. The price of good quality extra-long staple cotton expected to be over around Rs 6,000 to Rs 6,200 per quintal in December and January next year and farmers have been asked to go for cotton sowing. In Tamil Nadu, cotton was grown in an area of 0.1 million ha with production of 0.53 million bales (170 kg a bale) during 2014-15.

According to preliminary report by the government, cotton sowing as on 15th July, 2016 has been covered under 75.41 lakh hectares compared to 93.22 lakh hectares during the same period previous year.

According to the data from Union agriculture ministry's department of economics and statistics (DES) shows that area under cotton crop this season has declined to 2.56 lakh hectares in the state, the lowest since 1955-56. In 2015-16, cotton acreage in Punjab was at 4.50 lakh hectares. Acreage has declined mainly due to fear of Whitefly pest attack.

The Cotton Advisory Board has lowered cotton output in 2015-16 season on lower acreage. Cotton production estimates are 12 per cent lower at 338 lakh bales in 2015 -16 season compared to 386 lakh bales during the previous season. India's cotton imports have already touched 15 lb (14 lb) and may hit 18 lakh bales in next three months. The total cotton supply is estimated lower by three per cent to 419 lb (433 lb). Exports are seen higher at 68 lb (58 lb) even as domestic mill consumption dropping to 274 lb (278 lb) leading to higher demand of 376 lb (367 lb). The closing stock is expected to be lower at 43 lb (66 lb).

India exported 0.184 lakh bales of cotton last week (04 -10 July 2016), which was 0.196 lakh bales previous to last week (27 June -03 July 2016), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch.

Major importer of Indian cotton during the week (04 -10 July, 2016) was Bangladesh. According to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch, Bangladesh imported 0.111 lakh bales of cotton from India in the past week (04 -10 July, 2016). Other major importers were Vietnam, Indonesia, Pakistan and Japan and their imported volumes were 0.047 lakh bales, 0.011 lakh bales, 0.011 lakh bales and 0.002 lakh bales respectively.

Department of Agriculture, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its second advance estimates, has revised the cotton production estimates downwardly for the season 2015-16 at 306.92 lakh bales (of 170 kg each). For the season 2014-15, the estimate was 346.23 lakh bales according to the first advance estimates for the season.

The Foreign Agriculture Services (FAS), division of USDA has lowered the production forecast for India in its latest report to 356 lakh bales. The reason for the downfall in the revision is lower yield expectation in Punjab and Haryana due to the attack of white fly and impact of pink bollworm in Gujarat.

According to Cotton Association of India (CAI), the arrivals during 2015-16 season up to the end of April 2016 are estimated at 302.40 lakh bales, lower compared to previous year. This reduction in the arrivals of cotton is an indication of a lower crop this season.



International Fundamentals:

India is backing major cotton growing African countries in their demand for immediate elimination of cotton export subsidies and a timeline for reduction of domestic support by heavily subsidising members such as the US.

According to Karachi Cotton Association (KCA), lower output of cotton is expected in the 2016 -17 season compared to previous season. Due to lower production in the previous season and in the coming season, the local textile industry has to import raw cotton and ensure its contribution towards achieving the target of export fixed through exports of value added products as well as earning foreign exchange for the country.

According to USDA latest report, global 2015/16 cotton ending stocks are revised down this month. World 2015-16 cotton production is projected at 97.92 million bales, 18 per cent below last season. World ending stocks are now projected lower at 100.27 million bales. For India, production is forecast at 26.8 million bales, same as previous month's estimates and India's crop is estimated 9 per cent below 2014/15 and the lowest since 2009/10.

Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to firm in the near -term.
