

#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

**Market Outlook**: Cotton spot prices noticed mixed tone on Tuesday.

**In The News**: According to preliminary report by the government, cotton sowing as on 19th August, 2016 has been covered under 101.54 lakh hectares compared to 110.23 lakh hectares during the same period previous year.

According to farmers, pink bollworm pest attack has been reported in the Haveri district of Karnataka, where cotton is sown in about 1 lakh hectares annually. Previous year, the worm had affected Bt cotton crop in Raichur district. The kharif sowing of cotton in Haveri is done in 69,000 hectares land. According to the Joint Director of Agriculture of Haveri district, the pest attack is not alarming and has been reported in 500 hectares. However precautionary steps are being taken to sensitise farmers.

With a view to promote Cotton farming, during cotton season 2016-17, Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmer Welfare has fixed minimum support price for medium staple length cotton at Rs. 3860/- per quintal and for long staple at Rs. 4160/- per quintal.

The Cotton Advisory Board has lowered cotton output in 2015-16 season on lower acreage. Cotton production estimates are 12 per cent lower at 338 lakh bales in 2015 -16 season compared to 386 lakh bales during the previous season. India's cotton imports have already touched 15 lb (14 lb) and may hit 18 lakh bales in next three months. The total cotton supply is estimated lower by three per cent to 419 lb (433 lb). Exports are seen higher at 68 lb (58 lb) even as domestic mill consumption dropping to 274 lb (278 lb) leading to higher demand of 376 lb (367 lb). The closing stock is expected to be lower at 43 lb (66 lb).

India exported 0.132 lakh bales of cotton last week (01 -06 August 2016), which was 0.194 lakh bales previous to last week (25 -31 July 2016), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch.

Major importer of Indian cotton during the week (01 -06 August, 2016) was Bangladesh. According to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch, Bangladesh imported 0.129 lakh bales of cotton from India in the past week (01 -06 August, 2016). Other major importer was Pakistan and its imported volume was 0.003 lakh bales.

Department of Agriculture, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its second advance estimates, has revised the cotton production estimates downwardly for the season 2015-16 at 306.92 lakh bales (of 170 kg each). For the season 2014-15, the estimate was 346.23 lakh bales according to the first advance estimates for the season.

The Foreign Agriculture Services (FAS), division of USDA has lowered the production forecast for India in its latest report to 356 lakh bales. The reason for the downfall in the revision is lower yield expectation in Punjab and Haryana due to the attack of white fly and impact of pink bollworm in Gujarat.

According to Cotton Association of India (CAI), the arrivals during 2015-16 season up to the end of April 2016 are estimated at 302.40 lakh bales, lower compared to previous year. This reduction in the arrivals of cotton is an indication of a lower crop this season.



#### **International Fundamentals:**

The International Cotton Advisory reduced world cotton stock estimates and International cotton prices jumped to over 80 cents/lb in the second half of July 2016 from an average of 70 cents/lb for the rest of the season. Significantly lower crops in the five largest producing countries and higher than expected demand led to tighter stocks at the end of 2015/16, at which time world ending stocks were estimated to have fallen by 12% to 19.7 million tons. Stocks outside of China decreased by 9%, to 8.4 million tons, which is the lowest level since 2010/11, when they reached 8.3 million tons. Furthermore, strong demand in China has reduced its national stocks by 12%, to 11.3 million tons.

Zimbabwe is expecting a production of 30000 tonnes to 35000 tonnes in the current season compared to 102000 tonnes last year. This is mainly due to drought in last season and reduction in finance from cotton companies. The worst harvest for the country was in 1992, when only 52000 tonnes was produced because of drought.

According to USDA latest report, global 2015/16 cotton ending stocks are revised down this month. World 2015-16 cotton production is projected at 97.92 million bales, 18 per cent below last season. World ending stocks are now projected lower at 100.27 million bales. For India, production is forecast at 26.8 million bales, same as previous month's estimates and India's crop is estimated 9 per cent below 2014/15 and the lowest since 2009/10.

#### **Outlook**

### We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to firm in the near -term.
